Electronic Arts has announced the release of 'Syndicate,' by Bullfrog Productions Ltd. 'Syndicate' is a futuristic adventure set in the year 2096, when the technological world is racing to perfect 'Mind Chips', which will enable users to believe they are someone, something, or somewhere else. Meanwhile, a war breaks out, and in the aftermath, it has been broken down into major cities run by large corporations. As the player of 'Syndicate,' you must try to control the New World through the use of an array of cybernetic enhancements and futuristic weaponry. Some of the key features included in 'Syndicate' are the ability to construct Company Agents using cyborg parts and other supplies, the undertaking of missions, and realistic digital sound effects. Computer Game Review described 'Syndicate' as "...the best cyberpunk anything I've seen, read, or played." The format for 'Syndicate' is exclusively 3DO. One or two players can participate in this strategy/action adventure, and it is available now.

'Trip'd' basically features you in a race to destroy alien eggs as they fall to the earth. In order to do this, you must arrange four or more in a group, but if the group is a square, the eggs band together and form a super alien. The title was created by WARP Inc. of Japan and will be made available in July, at a suggested retail price of \$49.95.

Some of the key features included in "Space Hulk™: Corridors of Blood" are ray-traced character animations, fully interactive and first person action, pre-rendered interleaving animation sequences, and a realistic Heads-Up display. 'Space Hulk' is exclusively formatted for the 3DO system, and this action adventure is available now.

## **PANASONIC**

Panasonic has announced the release of a new version of their classic fighting game "Ballz™, The Director's Cut." This is the first truly 3-D fighting game for the 3DO system. Based on the critically acclaimed game

previously available for other platforms, "The Director's Cut" features three times more moves than the standard 2-D fighting game. ### **DKB'S WILDFIRE**

DKB has announced the release of the WildFire 060 for the Amiga 2000. The WildFire is the first in a series of 060 boards for the Amiga Computers. Boasted as the fastest accelerator for the A2000 to date, the board is expected to ship by late October or early November. Some of the Hardware features are a true 060 50MHz design, Lighting High Speed local 060 memory, supports interleaved memory, and it also supports posted writes to the Motherboard. It is compatible with the Video Toaster, and also with the MegAChip 2000/500. It requires Amiga Dos 2.1 or greater, and comes with a full two-year warranty. The suggested retail price of the WildFire 060 is \$1699.99.
