

Strahl

Panasonic Software Company has announced the release of Strahl, a Japanese animated adventure game for the 3DO platform. This real-time interactive drama has the player helping the young Alex Hawkfield to heed his destiny and become the king of a mythical land. Alex is moved to his fate by a mysterious old man. He must overcome unique challenges in order to recover the seven crystal gems that will help him. Can he slay the dragon, destroy the evil golem and still save the kingdom? The title features a hi-fi musical score and 48 possible endings. Strahl will be available in July at an SRP of \$59.95.

Space Pirates

This latest 3DO title from American Laser Games has players blasting their way through alien worlds and saving hostage space colonists. Lead by the evil Captain Talon, these planet-hopping pirates have taken these innocent colonists to a space ship. The player takes on the role of a Star Ranger who is given the assignment of saving the colonists and collecting energy crystals from three different worlds. These crystals power the star-splitter cannon which is the only weapon that can destroy the pirate ship Black Dragon. Victory comes when the cannon is charged, the pirate ship is destroyed and the player has a final confrontation with Captain Talon. Space Pirates was set to be in stores by the end of June with an SRP of \$59.95. The game is compatible with ALG's GAMEGUN.

ALG has also announced that a two player version of the GAMEGUN will be available in August. This will enable two people to compete simultaneously against each other within the same game. This feature will work with the games Mad Dog II: the Lost Gold™, Crime Patrol™ and Space Pirates™ as wells as the future ALG games Drug Wars™ (July), The Last Bounty Hunter™ (September) and Shoot Out at Old Tucson™ (October). The SRP on the two-player GAMEGUN will be \$59.95.
