

Button, and Down on the directional pad. When a code has been correctly entered, the character will "energize" and the game will become active. If you are not successful, press the pause button twice to reset it and begin again.

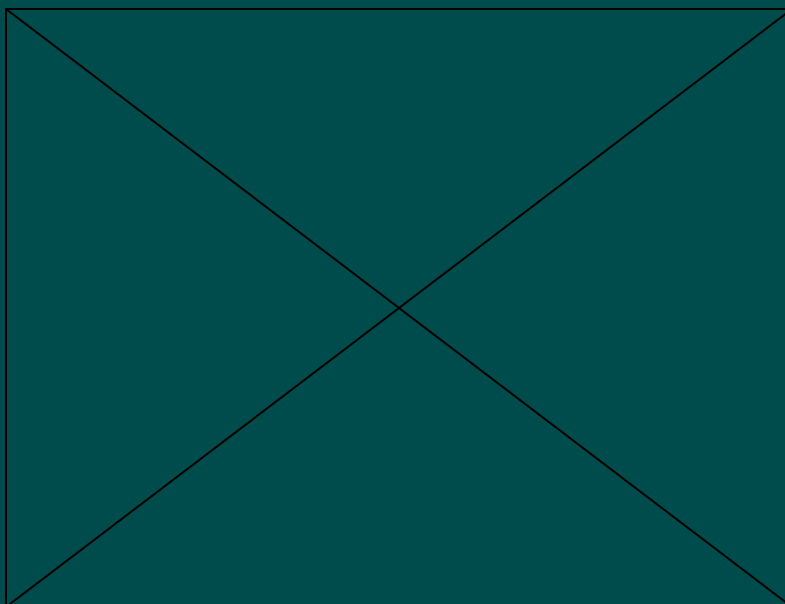
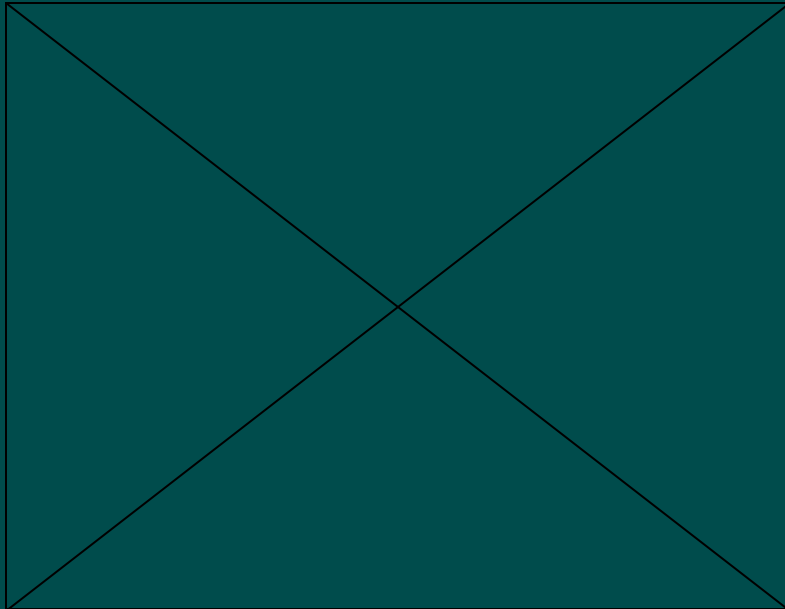
LCD NUCLEAR makes GEX bullet-proof from spikes, monsters, etc. Be careful, GEX can still drown, fall endlessly, and more to a quick death.

LCD RUNNER makes GEX run like the wind, for a while. Use this when you need a little extra speed.

LCD EEL gives GEX a real charge. Suddenly he has electric breath that splits into three directions.

LCD RUBBER puts more than a little spring into GEX's step. This one will take a little getting used to in order to handle it effectively.

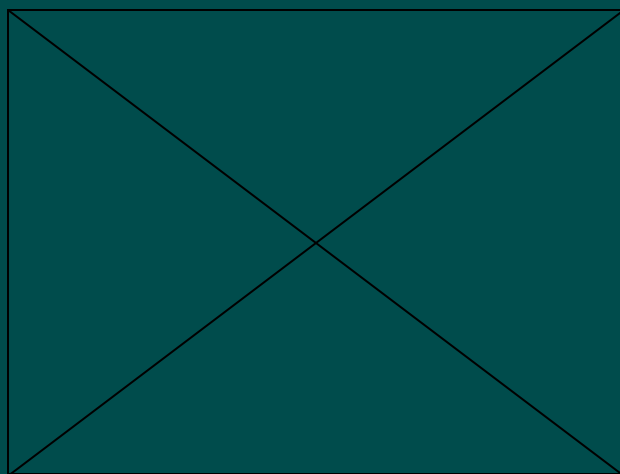

GEX is Popular

Crystal Dynamics has sold hundreds of thousands of GEX packages to 3DO users all over the world. In addition, Panasonic has included GEX as a pack-in with all of their current 3DO FZ-10 systems. With this much activity, it was only a matter of time before users began discovering cheats buried within the program. The following are the ones we have received from a variety of users.

GEX can get around a little safer, a little faster, and even a little nastier with a little help from his friends. LCD NUCLEAR (right) gives GEX some protection against the elements, LCD RUNNER (top far right) provides a burst of speed, LCD EEL (far middle) creates electrified GEX breath, and LCD RUBBER (far bottom) bounces GEX to new heights.

The Codes

In order to implement the following codes, you must first learn the special GEX code. The directional pad on the 3DO controller goes in four directions: Up, Down, Right, and Left. This can also be noted as North, South, East, and West respectively. The GEX code reads these as both U, D, R, L, N, S, E, and W. P stands for pause, X stands for stop, and the A, B, and C letters follow their respective buttons.

To enter a code, you must first press the pause key. Then hold the Right Shift button down and spell the code using the letters on the controller as described above. All codes (as far as we have discovered), begin with the letters LCD (that would be Left on the directional pad, C
