A short-tempered, 'Old School' cop, the Chief of Pursuit Force began his career on the mean streets of Capital City. His career was forged the hard way over a long period of time, starting as a beat cop he worked his way through the ranks and eventually became Chief of Police for the whole of Capital City. What he lacked in natural ability he made up for in raw determination, and as such he is resentful of cops who haven't proved themselves in the way that he had to. During his six years as Police Chief, he has worked to lower the city's ever increasing crime rate. Recently, however, the crime rate has grown exponentially and the Mayor's attention is now firmly focussed on the Chief.

Initially the Chief made it very clear to the Mayor that the Capital police were simply not equipped to deal with this new breed of criminal and that a full structure and law review would be required to combat these super villains. Typically however, the Mayor refused to sanction any of the Chief's proposed plans, simply because it would cost the state too much money.

This infuriated the Chief. All the years in the force protecting civilians and making Capital City a safe place to live, seemed futile. Only a politician could put a price on people's lives. The chief needed a solution and fast. The Mayor's spin doctors had turned the attention of the cities public from his office and onto the police force itself.
