Character Information – The Killer 66

Originating in the Far East, the Killer 66 are a US splinter group of their Head Chapter 'The 66'. The group is now a global organisation with gang divisions in Russia, Europe and the United States. A fearsome group whose lineage can be traced back to the 12th century where they were an army of hired mercenaries, the Killer 66 has evolved over a number of years and meets illegal demands whatever they may be and at whatever the cost. To call the gang brutal would be an understatement, they are highly focussed and will not let anyone or anything stand in the way of their goals.

The gang has only just arrived in Capital City but have already made a huge impact. They specialise in drug trafficking and auto theft to order, whilst being engaged in a bloody war with the other gangs, in order to take control of the City.

The Killer 66 utilise super charged GT cars and superbikes which prominently display their gang colours. These vehicles are highly armoured and extremely fast making them difficult to chase down or destroy. The gang has no empathy for civilian life and property and this is perhaps their most dangerous attribute.

Undercover and highway cops have reported sightings of a huge vehicle, heavily armoured with an arsenal of heavy weapons that has decimated their fellow officers, these reports however cannot be substantiated. It is generally believed that this may be the gang boss's personal vehicle.

This gang is perhaps the greatest single threat to the security of the entire state.

The 'Killer 66' Boss- Hiro Arakawa

This character is the most powerful gang boss of 'The 66' outside of the Far East. He has worked his way up the ranks in his native homeland, taking out any that stepped in his path to power. He is feared by his gang members and is the mastermind behind the global expansion. He is a traditionalist and as such, shows little in the way of mercy to those who cross him or fail to do their duty properly. Hiro is the brains behind the Killer 66; however he is also formidable in combat.

The 'Killer 66' Lieutenant- Sudeko

The boss's right hand man. Sudeko's father was a member of 'The 66' and at a very early age he was orphaned during a police raid on his families home, following this he was raised by Arakawa and the 'The 66'. It was during his youth that he gained training in both martial art and modern combat techniques. As he grew older the hatred for law and the police was burnt into his psyche by the gang and his experience, at the age of 13 he became an assassin for 'The 66', a job, needless to say, that he excelled at. He has a particular taste for killing cops and takes great pride in his kill count. A feared man who will never lose his taste for death.
