After the main network installation has been completed, each individual workstation must be set up to run CorelFLOW. For more detailed installation instructions and troubleshooting information, refer to the *Getting Started Section of the CorelFLOW User's Manual*.

Note: Windows 3.1 or higher must be installed and working properly on the network server before installing CorelFLOW.

Welcome to the Network Workstation Setup

Customizing Your Copy of CorelFLOW

Type your name and the software's serial number in the provided list boxes to customize your copy of CorelFLOW. After the installation is complete, this information will appear in the About dialog box (Help menu). Then, should you have to contact Customer Support, and they ask for your software's serial number, you will be able to reference it quickly and easily from within the application.

If you want to bypass this option, choose **Continue** to move on to the next dialog box or **Exit** to quit the installation program.

Choosing a Destination Directory

The Directory list box displays the default drive and directory (C:\CFLOW20) where the program files will be installed on your hard drive. If you prefer to install the files to a different location, type the full path of the alternate directory in the provided list box.

Total Disk Space Required

The total space required value is a measure of how many kilobytes of space the selected files will take up on your hard drive. Included in this calculation are extra files required to run the program.

Selecting Files to Install

Lists the files (fonts, symbol libraries etc.) you can choose to install on your hard drive. For each selected item, the amount of disk space required is listed in the right-hand column. The <u>total disk space required</u> for all currently selected files and the space available on your hard drive are listed at the bottom left of the dialog box.

Dialog Box Options

File Check Boxes

By default, all files are selected for installation, but you can deselect any file by clicking the check box associated with the file name to clear it.

Customize Buttons

Opens a dialog box where you can select or deselect individual files (fonts, symbol libraries). To conserve disk space, only select the files you require.

Continue

Finalizes the selections and proceeds with the installation.

Selecting Smart Symbol Libraries

Choose which symbol libraries you want installed by adding or deleting library names to and from the Install list box. Use the function buttons to move names from one list to the other. For more information, click on 🔳 next to the name.

Moves all names to the Do Not Install list box.

Selecting True Type Fonts

Choose which fonts you want installed by adding or deleting font names to and from the Install list box. Consult the *CorelFLOW User's Manual* for samples of the supported fonts. Use the function buttons to move names from one list to the other. For more information, click on a next to the name.
