First Demo Source Text File
for *Scholar's Aid*

This is a short source text file to demonstrate *Scholar's Aid*. Figure, table, and equation codewords may be embedded in the text as often as desired: (Figure «fig1p1d1», Table «tbl1p1d1») and equation («eqn1p1d1»):

$$Y = a + bt \quad (\text{«eqn1p1d1»})$$

The codewords are your choice, except for the first character and the length (must be eight characters plus the brackets). New figures (Fig. «fig2secd»), tables (Table «tbl2rate»), and equations may be added where they are needed and *Scholar's Aid* can be used to renumber them automatically. References are cited numerically using codewords in the source text that refer to specific references in your bibliographic database. The following codewords refer to two references in the SA Demo Ref File: which may be formatted as needed in your text: on the line, «83edw561», «82smi010»; or as superscripts. «83edw561», «82Smi010»

You may also use author-and-year referencing or author and order-in-text referencing, e.g., Smith et al. («82Smi010»), Edwards and Allen («83edw561»). If author-and-year referencing is selected in *Scholar's Aid* the reference codewords will be replaced with the publication year and a, b, c, etc., when needed to distinguish identical citations, Edwards and Allen («83edw021»).

The first line in the draft file as it appears on the screen is a statement for the print merge part of MS-Word. It does not show up on the printout when you specify print merge. If the source text file contains reference codewords, it may end with the following line, which refers to the file "SA, Ref List Format" containing the List Formats for printing the reference list:

«INCLUDE SA, Ref List Format»
