

System File Definitions

Note: This list attempts to identify all those files anywhere in the system folder that have an impact on the operation of the system

- *File Name : Finder*
 - ◊ *Special Status = OPEN FILE/ACTIVE PRINTER*
 - ◊ *Version = Version number of file if available*
 - ◊ *Type = Finder Type designation of file and (class) if known*
 - ◊ *Has INIT = Does this file have an INIT (System Extension) resource? If so, and the Type is either INIT, cdev, RDEV, scri, or ddev then the INIT resource is executed at startup.*
 - ◊ *Patched System = Does this file have a "ptch" resource. If so, the system is automatically patched by the resource at startup.*
 - ◊ *Creator = Finder Creator designation and (descriptor) if known*
 - ◊ *Status = Brief explanation of status/impact of file on system*
 - ◊ *Modified = Modification date and time*
 - ◊ *Path = Where the file can be found. This is named Target Path if this is an alias file and it points to the original file.*
 - ◊ *Alias Path = If this is an alias file, this points to the location of the alias file. [System 7]*
