

Serial Port Definitions

- *Serial Port Attributes :*
 - ◊ *GP1a is connected to DCDA = Does the modem port provide handshaking on pin 7 of the connector in addition to pins 1 and 2?*
 - ◊ *GP1a is connected to DCDB = Does the printer port provide handshaking on pin 7 of the connector in addition to pins 1 and 2?*
 - ◊ *GP1a is connected to RTXC = Does the modem port provide support for devices with separate data clocks, such as synchronous modems?*
.....
- *Port Config :*
 - ◊ *Configuration Type = Specifies the configuration, either serial (on either port) or AppleTalk (just on the printer port). For AppleTalk, the version is also specified.*
 - ◊ *Baud = For serial only, the number of bits per second transmission speed*
 - ◊ *Parity = For serial only, the parity*
 - ◊ *Bits/Char = For serial only, the number of bits/char recognized*
 - ◊ *Stop Bits = For serial only, the number of stop bits*
