Serial Port Definitions

• Serial Port Attributes :

- ♦ GPIa is connected to DCDa = Does the modem port provide handshaking on pin 7 of the connector in addition to pins 1 and 2?
- ◊ GPIa is connected to DCDb = Does the printer port provide handshaking on pin 7 of the connector in addition to pins 1 and 2?
- GPIa is connected to RTxCa = Does the modem port provide support for devices with separate data clocks, such as synchronous modems?

• Port Config :

Configuration Type = Specifies the configuration, either serial (on either port) or AppleTalk (just on the printer port). For AppleTalk, the version is also specified.

 δ Baud = For serial only, the number of bits per second transmission speed

- δ Parity = For serial only, the parity
- δ Bits/Char = For serial only, the number of bits/char recognized
- δ Stop Bits = For serial only, the number of stop bits
