The "MINISTAR - BBS" (509) 529-5888 is Walla Walla's oldest and largest bulletin board. It serves a large host of user interest, and is a great way of expressing your opinions freely. Although, it should be kept in mind that the users of the board are also known to express there pros or cons of your comments and or suggestions. Be it all that it may, it is one thing for sure; it's great fun!

The "MINISTAR" is a great hang out for anyone with an interest in communications via modem, be it large or small. The board is based on a 80286 system with a 40 meg hard disk, also supported is a CD-Rom with over 10,000 files. The "MINISTAR" is a user supported system, therefor it is tailored to its users needs and desires. All that means it's not free, however it is worth paying for. The cost to access the "MINISTAR" is \$20.00 for a six month period. Currently it only has one phone line with one or two more lines planed in the near future.

The "MINISTAR" uses the "PC Board" software and is very easy to maneuver around in. It has several different "hot" topic groups for opened discussion including, Photography, shooting, Amigas, IBM, Macintosh, Games, For Sale, Astronomy, and General store just to name a few. Users are free to upload or download anything, with credit given to new uploads within a certain date of creation. The "MINISTAR" is awaiting your call, give it a try and call today. •
