POP3Stat is a little Tool for checking if you have mail in your POP3-mailbox. I wrote it because I found it annoying starting a whole mailer just to look if I have some mail. There also exists the very usefull YGMail but it is in fact a YAM companion and you have to have YAM installed to use it and it is quiet hard to check many POP3-accounts at once. POP3Stat needs only the ixemul.library, the ixnet.library (always the newest, in these days (05-Sep-99) is V48 the state of art) and a MC68020 to be happy.

POP3Stat is still in beta-status so you can expect many bugs! I'm using it quiet often and have no problems, but who knows what'll happen to you (/your Amiga)!

- · Nearly as much POP3-accounts as you want.
- · Checking all or only one POP3-account.
- · Multiple Prefsfiles supported
- If mails are found, you can simply put it out, return a certain returncode, set an ENV-variable or start a program.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Do as much as like of the above actions, even none or all is supported.

Yes, I admit, that I've stolen some ideas from YGMail :-).
