The Universal Monitor is capable of connecting to very much more than simply video games however. On-board S-Video, Composite Video and Twin RCA Stereo Phono inputs allow instant connection to a multitude of AV sources from DVD player to Camcorder, and the supplied SCART Input lead, supports both Composite and RGB from any SCART enabled video source. To further aid in compatibility the Monitor is able to display 50 or 60Hz images (For use with Pal 60 or selected video games), as well as being fully PAL and NTSC compatible.

JOYTECH have worked to ensure that the viewer is drawn in to both vision and sound, and thus have included State of the Art 'WOW' SRS® 3D Surround Sound. The latest incarnation of SRS®, 'WOW' allows users to tailor the sound enhancement facility, alter the level of bass and treble, and deliver unprecedented spatial sound, exceptionally clear in tone, and ideal for use in a portable device.

For the first time on a JOYTECH Monitor, the new unit comes equipped with full 'OSD' (On Screen Display), allowing instant access to information on chosen inputs, adjust various sound levels, and access the models comprehensive menu system.

Another first arrives with the addition of the supplied Slim Line Remote Control, allowing simple and convenient operation of the Monitor whilst remaining seated.

Powered by a 12Volt Power Adapter, the Monitor also comes supplied with an In-Car Adaptor, allowing endless play on the move. Furnished with a supplied chrome stand, (fully removable for flush wall mounting) the Monitor is fully at home on the move, on the wall, on the desk, or indeed anywhere with access to power!
