NAME : The name of the file which contains the Cookies MARK : A String which seperates the Cookies. Default is '%%'. To stop SelectCookie from doing whatever it is just doing, just send him a Break [CtrlC or Kitkat :)].

1.6 CookieFileFormat

Well, at first, your Cookiefile should start with 1 up to n lines of seperationmarks. Then there should be cookies [Gen:1,2-3] each one seperated with a similar [not the same ;)] mark. At the end, well there should be one final seperationmark.

And now to something completely different, an example:
