1.2 AmigaGuide Information

AmigaGuide Information

The AmigaGuide program is used to display AmigaGuide files on AmigaDOS 2.x systems, while Multiview is used to display AmigaGuide files on AmigaDOS 3.x systems. AmigaGuide v34 is included with PageStream and will be installed if you have AmigaDOS 2 and do not already have AmigaGuide in your Sys:Utilities directory. Multiview is included with all versions of AmigaDOS 3 so you will not need this.

You will find a few Visual Reference buttons in the help system. Clicking on these will display a picture if ARexx is started. AmigaGuide does not allow pictures and text to be mixed together, hence separate picture windows must be used.
