1.2 Introduction

Welcome to DLDCheck version 4.1a Evaluation.
DLDCheck is coded by Rasmus K. Ursem in pure Assembler.

This is the evaluation version of DLDCheck 4.1a. DLDCheck 4.1a is shareware.
See more in the

registration
section.

DLDCheck can be used to remove (and add) BBS advertisements, so-called
banners, from lha-archives. DLDCheck can also remove banners from textfiles.

DLDCheck is one of the most configurable strippers ever made, this gives
extremely high flexibility and efficiency. So high efficiency that once a
banner is detected, it will never show up again! (If you set the prefs good.)
DLDCheck can handle *ANY* bannertype. IFF/Gif/executeables/icons/you name it.
All you have to do is detect these special non-ASCII files.
DLDCheck, especially the registered version is very efficient (98-100%) and
another very nice thing is the "Autodelete" in IK, when I strip banners, I'll
only have to delete 1-2 banners myself for every 10 archives, the rest is
killed by "autodelete". Until this date (29.07.95) the registered users (10-12)
has removed more than 100MB's of banners since the 01.01.95.

1.3 The war between adders and strippers.

They have been there for quite some time, few like them, sysops need them. BBS-adds, banners, advertisements are they called, spreading almost like an infection, making your archives and your phonebill grow huge.

Over a year ago, a friend of mine used a program called lhacheck or something like that. At that time the wildcard banners was rare and stripping banners was actually only calling LHA with the -i option. Well somebody found out that LHA couldn't delete files containing wildcards, very quickly the so-called wildcard-banners was added in large amount. The strippers couldn't remove these banners by use of LHA, so routines to seek these wildcard-banners was made, a couple of months passed, and everything went berserk again. The latest was to add random generated banners, so the wildcard-strippers would pass these banners. Strippers now had to check each file for look-alike banners, the so-called intelligent killmodes was born, making it hard for randomgenerated as well as unknown banners to survive. For a moment we thought we was safe, but no. Now they add executeables, huge gif/iff pictures and icons. New routines has to be coded to remove these new banners, CRC checking is a very efficient way to kill ALL banners, DLDCheck 4.1a support this killmode. The war goes on...

I have tried to see it from the sysops point of view. Banners is necessary for a BBS to survive. The what do we do? Today almost all archives use the file_id.diz standard, could we create a standard for advertising BBS-systems? Yes we can, but it need all sysops support. DLDCheck could create a file called "Seenby.bbs". This file contain a list of BBS the archive has passed through. Each BBS has 2 lines of text, the first line gives info about BBS name, Sysop name, group name, baudrate, phone number and 80 chars of your additional information.

THE PROBLEM: Convincing all the sysops that we are fed up with their banners and make them support this standard of advertisement instead of adding 10 banners to each archive.

Some of my most crazy kills:

In an archive with the size of 54kb I removed 52kb of banners. These banners was wildcard, random, executeables, and iff-pictures a total of more than 20 banners in the archive.

In an archive with the size of 84kb I found a gif-picture with the unpacked size of 109kb! + a lot of other banners.

In one archive I have deleted more than 30 banners.

I take no responsibility for datacorruption or deletion of data caused by DLDCheck, anyway it's tested many times and has shown few errors so far.

NOTE: DO NOT ADD THE BANNER NAMED '*' THIS IS A WILDCARD AND ALL FILES IN ARCHIVE WILL BE DELETED!!!!

(DLDCheck Version 2.2+ can kill wildcardbanners.)

You can also use CRC on ASCII/Ansi, but don't use on banners which has a line or two at the bottom with text in this style.

Because CRC checking is dependant on the CRC in the archive and this changes if the contents of the file change. Instead add some high-probability words and use IKs "Del files above" to autodelete the files.

- If the main kill or Intelligent Killmode cannot delete/unpack a file it is probably because the filename contains some kind of illegal chars. I have noticed that LHA uses special non-standard wildcards for some internal stuff. (e.g. \$\$)
- Special Words MUST start with a letter or a number because the ASCII-checker will take all other ASCII-chars as "Banner-chars".
- Special words which is allmost alike is not wise. The best way of explaining this is with an example. The following is a list of medium-probability words.

DLDCheck will only find "Sysop" and leave out the rest, simply because it find "Sysop" before "Sysop: TheSysop". Instead you should do like this.

The ":" and the " " will be handled anyway.

- Be very careful with these options/settings.

- CompareKill/Use normal compare.
- Intelligent/SpecialWords/Kill high, skip low.
- If You not use Intelligent/"Check filetype fast" DLDCheck might start checking misc files. Icons have somehow a very high percentage.

1.14 Why to register DLDCheck 4.1a

This is what you get when you register DLDCheck.

- * Access to the Hot-Line. (+45 86755547)
- * Non-crippled version of DLDCheck.
- * Other free utils from Dreamline Designs if you want them.
- * Access to the User-conference on Stargate. This conf is for registered users only and holds some inside info and beta-releases.

DLDCheck is crippled in these options.

Maintenance option:

When the maintenance option doesn't find any banners, DLDCheck will skip the mainkill because this is checking the archive twice and getting the same result.

NOTE: This doesn't work in the evaluation version.

Intelligent Killmode:

-Added/Improved: 3 Types of words. Used to determine a textfiles probability of being a banner. See more information in the DLDCheckPrefs

NOTE: Crippled in evaluation version.

-Added: Fast filetype check.

NOTE: Not optimized in evaluation version.

-Added: Average wordlength checking. (Banners usually have very low lix-value.)

NOTE: Not optimized in evaluation version.

-Added: Check in subdirs.

NOTE: Not available in evaluation version.

-Added: Adding subdir-banner-names to killbanners and killbanners.addlist.

NOTE: Not available in evaluation version.

-Added: CRC checking, this is a very efficient way to kill ANY add including IFF/GIF/Icons/executeable/you name it.

The routine is based on the so-called CRC. This is a checksum LHA uses to check the files. If DLDCheck finds a file which matches the filesize and CRC it can be autodeleted. This is very fast.

NOTE: Limited in the evaluation version.

Compare Killmode:

-Added: Compare killmode can sort extensions. In DLDCheckPrefs you can set extensions which this killmode will NOT delete.

NOTE: Limited in evaluation version to a maximum of 4.

1.15 A little note to crackers.

Some lamebrain tried to crack DLDCheck 4.0, however he did not succeed because it can't be done. And why? Simply because the code in the registered version does NOT exist in the evaluation version. So don't try to do it, it's a waste of time. If you find a cracked version don't bother downloading it, because it's a fake!

Furthermore all registered versions of DLDCheck has x special encrypted serial numbers build in. So if an illegal version is circulating, I'll know who spread it!

(Comparing 2 registered versions will not help you because the positions are different from version to version.)

V1.01 -Bug Fix: Could load files with spaces. Also released at The Party
III

V1.1 -DLDCheck now uses ReadArgs() from the dos.library instead of just
getting it from the CLI. ReadArgs() is more systemfriendly and
DLDCheck will therefore be forward compatible.
-Bug Fix: DLDCheck could misunderstand a '-' in the filename as a
option. This is also removed by using ReadArgs. (Thanks goes to Zest/
Triangle 3532 for telling me how to use ReadArgs.)
-Removed the ? option and included amigaguide instructions instead.
-Added LHA option -Qo and -Qw. Added because some bannernames
includes '-' and other wierd characters LHA could misunderstand as
user-selected options, unfortunately LHA has a bug so -Qw dosn't
work. (Don't add the '*'-banner in the KillBanners list, because
this will delete all files in the archive!!!!)
-Added a utility to put a new banner in the list. I coded this
small utility because I didn't wanted to load an editor every time
I found a new banner. (I find a lot! :-l)

This Version is not released to public.

V2.1 -Added S=SAFE option. Purpose to insure survival of your precious
HD. The reason is yet another bug in LHA, sometimes the Amiga
crashed while packing data, and thereby using the HD for saving.
The result: A Currrupted HD and hours of repairwork.
-Bugfix: During MODE Show, DLDCheck didn't show anything if the
file T:KilledToDay was not present.

- V2.2 -Bugfix and repairwork on the Safemode option. DLDCheck now ask "skip safemode or quit" if the archive cannot be copied to mem.
-Added Wildcard kill. Filenames with the following letters will be deleted: * # ? ~ |. This will not happen if the archive is too big. I will maybe make this with buffers later.
-Removed LHAs "-Qw" option because it doesn't work anyway.
- V2.3 -Added CompareKillmode. This new killmode stores the archivename and kills any name in archive that looks like it. Files to be deleted by this option is "Filename.#?" Option added because some guys have started to add banners with almost the same name as the archive.
Note: You should only use this option with care.
-Bugfix and repair work on the safemode option.
- V2.4 -Added Intelligent killmode(IK). Since some guys get wiser and wiser to avoid getting their banners killed, (Such as generating random-names.) I added this routine.
-In connection with the IK I added an auto DLDDAdd. In other words. If IK finds a banner it will automatically add the name to DLDChecker:Killbanners. Why? Because IK is slow compared to deleting from a filelist.
-Added some banners to the list from a file called "2BAD.NFO". This file was somebody's killbanners list, released to public. This version of the Killbanners file is roughly sorted so you can easily insert your own banners.
-Added a printline when using the Safe option, so you can see what archive you are processing.
-Added some new chars to the Wildcard kill routine.
- V2.5 -Bugfix: Using safemode an error occurred during the use of "Copy" DLDCheck would delete the archive. Thanks goes to *Warner of Creed*.
-Bugfix: Using safemode and the wildcard option DLDCheck would crash on some large archives.
-Added an option in the intelligent killmode so you can remove the banner from the archive without adding it to the "Killbanners".
-Added a lot of banners to the KillBanners list. Thanks goes to Warner of Creed.
- V3.0 -Bugfix: IK would crash if files with filesize=0 occurred.
-Repairwork: IKs checkroutine had some minor bugs, now fixed.
-Added: BrainFile. Yes, DLDCheck can learn words to check in IK. The brainfile is also used in connection with the new killmode.
-Added: New KillMode to remove banners from textfiles. Artificial Intelligence (AI) is used to learn the ways of the user. In other words DLDCheck will learn how YOU use DLDCheck, and then use this.
-Added: DLDEdit, a small utility to delete doublelines and wildcard filenames in a SORTED Killbanners file. (Sort with CygnusEd)
-Added: New chars to wildcardkill. Now deletes files with these chars: *#?><|><<@~^!@#\$\times\$; (This method is faster than LHA.)
-Expanded: The Show option now shows the LHA-archive killsize, text killsize and the words in memory.
-Added: A lot of banners from different files. KillBanners is now more than 25Kb.
- V3.1 -Bugfix: Major problems in brainfile.
-

-Bugfix: DLDCheck Could set the delete point before the file starts or after End Of File. Now fixed.

-Bugfix: IK would crash if files with filesize=0 occurred. Wasn't repaired well in 3.0.

-Repairwork: The checkline routine would, until now, take spaces for ASCIILogochars. Spaces are now total out of the evaluation process.

-Repairwork: When changing the front delete position You had to wait for a total print of the start of the file. Now DLDCheck prints the last 12 lines before and after the delete position.

-Expanded: Show option expanded and readout of remembered words changed a little bit.

-Added: Using Textkillmode. The checkline routine would take a total line of ---- or ==== as an ASCIILogocharline. These lines are now total out of the evaluation process. An AI sort-method will try to determine these lines as underlines or just a good-for-nothing partline.

-Added: Using Textkillmode. A line to tell you where DLDCheck will delete. Reason: ANSI readout would fuck up the show mode in DLDCheck 3.0.

-Added: DLDCheck now print the file being processed during textmode.

-Added: Using IKA. "Train" and "Quit" added. "Train" will train the BrainFile. "Quit" will quit the IKA instead of just cancel the file being processed.

-Added: Using IKA. After viewing a file containing colorchanges DLDCheck now resets the printcolor.

-Added: Using IKA. Spaces, Tabs and CRs are now out of the evaluation process.

-Info: Sourcesize 92103 bytes, 5877 lines of code.

V4.0 -Added: New option called maintenance. This option is used to update the killbannerslist. Each name in the list will get a number which is the last time this banner was deleted from an archive. The reason is the extreme large killbannerslist, this takes very long time to load. You can set the amount of accesses before removal in the DLDCheckPrefs program. See the
DLDCheckPrefs
section.
DLDCheck is not used to remove names from the list because this takes long time. This is done by DLDEdit. See the
How to Use
section.
When the maintenance option doesn't find any banners, DLDCheck will skip the mainkill because this is checking the archive twice and getting the same result. NOTE: This doesn't work in the evaluation version.

-Added: New Mode Configure. This new mode can take a configuration file generated by
DLDConfig
and use this as a template.
The goal is to avoid entering long templates in the shell. Instead just enter the saved configfile and DLDCheck will read arguments from this file.

-Added/Improved: The show mode is expanded with a lot of counters, accesses ect ect. This is output is determined by the prefs.

-Changed: Keep option. You can set you own filecomment. See the DLDCheckPrefs

section.

-Intelligent Killmode:

-Bugfix: IK mode crashed if LHA failed when extracting files from archive. No fixed.

-Bugfix: IK mode found wierd banners. Now fixed.

-Bugfix: The ASCII-Checker had minor bugs. Now fixed.

The "check methods" bevelbox.

- "Check filetype fast" is used to enable DLDChecks own filetype check. This filetype checker will look at the first 100 bytes of a file. This is much faster than using FileID.library.
 - "Use FileID library" is used to enable filetype checking by FileID.library. Use this in connection with fast filetype check and you have a very efficient filetype checker. The advantage of enabling these filetype checkers is to make sure DLDCheck don't start looking in e.g. executeables.
 - "Check wordlength" is used to enable wordlength checking. Since banners usually contains of very short words this checkmethod is used to sort documents with long words out.
 - "Check # of Lines" is used to enable this checkmethod. You can set how many lines a banner max contains.
 - "Check compress ratio" will enable the ratio checking. Since textfiles usually has high compress ratios you can use this to sort out files. The advantage of this is to prevent DLDCheck to unpack files from the archive to evaluate them.
 - "Check special words" is used to enable the wordchecking. In the bevelbox below can you enter words for this checkmethod. The checkmethod is used to evaluate the textfiles. See more below.
 - "Use CRC checking" is used to enable CRC-Checking. This Checkmethod is the absolute fastest way to remove *ANY* banner, once DLDCheck has found the banner once. It checks the CRC and file-size for the files and if a known banner is found it is deleted. It is fast because NO analyse routines is used in the files.
- The Settings gadgets is used to specify settings for the checkmethod just left of the gadgets.

The "Main limits" bevelbox.

- "Minimum size" is used to set the minimum size of files to evaluate.
 - "Maximum size" is used to set the maximum size of files to evaluate.
 - "Show&Ask below" is used to set the size of files DLDCheck should evaluate no matter what. The reason is that some files doesn't contain any data, but the filename is a banner. E.g. "DAIL+45XXXX0431" size 5 bytes.

SWL is Special words low probability.

CRC is CRC Checking.

- "Count banners" enables the count option. When this option is set DLDCheck will count accesses to IK, killed banners, removed banners and autoremoved banners. If this option is set DLDChecks showmode will print these counts.

- "Check in subdirs". Search for banners in subdirs.

- "Store new banners". Store new banners in DLDChecker:NewBanners.

In some of the settings windows is a checkbox called "Use wordlength in final analyze" or something like that. This will make the check affect the percentage printed when a file is found. The amount of percent the final analyze is affected can be set for each check by setting the "Influence"-gadget.

An example of a positive check:

```
The main check for chars like /\_ - gives:           63%
The # of Lines check is positive +5%                 68% (Influence = 5%)
The Compress ratio is positive +8%                   76% (Influence = 8%)
```

NOTE: Wordlength check has special info. See below.

When opening the settings for WordLength.

- "Remember largest word". When this is set the checkmethod "Check wordlength" will store the largest wordlength for future checking. DLDCheck will then only pass files with average wordlength 1 greater than the largest wordlength.

If you not set this the checkmethod will only pass files with average wordlength equal or lesser than the limit set in the "Avg. wordlength"-gadget.

- "StepSize" is used to calculate the influence on the final analyze. See below.

- "Avg. Wordlength" specifies the average wordlength for this checkmethod. If you are using "Use wordlength in final analyze" the final analyze will be affected like this.

$$\text{Percentage} = \text{Percentage} + ((\text{Avg Wordlength} - \text{Actual Avg wordlength}) * \text{Stepsize})$$

Example:

The Percentage is 78%, the Actual Avg wordlength is 3, the Avg. word-

length is set to 4 and the stepsize is 2%

After this check the percentage is

Percentage = $78 + ((4-3)*2 = 78 + 2 = 80\%$

When opening the settings for # of Lines.

- "Maximum # of Lines" will set the maximum # of Lines. If you use "Use # of Lines in final analyze" and the file has less than the amount specified here, the value specified in "Influence" will be added to the final percentage. Else the file will be evaluated further or if the # of lines exceeds this amount the file will be skipped.

When opening the settings for ratio check.

- "Minimum ratio" is used to set the minimum ratio for the checkmethod "Check compress ratio". It works exactly the same way as # of lines.

When opening the settings for Special words.

This window contains 3 listviewboxes. These are used as the other listviews in e.g. wildcardkillmode. The 3 types of words is defined below. NOTE: The evaluation version of DLDCheck 4.1a will handle the 3 types as equals. In other words don't enter anything in the low probability list.

- High probability: This type of words are ONLY found in banners. The wordlength will be multiplied with 2 and added to the percentage. Words in this group: boardnames, sysopnames, groupnames ect ect.

- Medium probability: This type of words are most likely found in banners, but could also be found in textfiles. The wordlength will be added to the percentage. Words in this group: Sysop, cosysop, wares, bbs, node, ect ect.

- Low probability: This type of words are almost NEVER found in banners. The wordlength will be multiplied with 2 and subtracted from the percentage. Words in this group: Assign, Printf, move.l, loadwb, path ect ect.

- "Kill high, skip low." If you use this DLDCheck will kill the file if it finds a word from the High-probability-group and skip it if it finds a word from the low-probability-group. If Both groups is found you can select the action in the cycle-gadget just right of this gadget. If you use this you must be very sure you don't have any "Maybes" in the high probability-group.

- "Action if high and low found." This is used to specify the action if DLDCheck finds both high and low-probabilty-words. The 3 options.

- Normal: Proceed as nothing happed and if the percentage is high enough ask/autodelete.

- Kill: Autodelete the file.

-Skip: Skip the file.

-"Check max words." This is the max number of special words you want DLDCheck to Look for. Used to speed up the checking.

When opening the settings for CRC-Checking.

-"Action when found" specifies what you want DLDCheck to do with the file.

-"Autodelete" will delete the file automatically.

-"Affect analyze!" will affect the final analyze with the value set in the "influence" gadget.
