

After The Logo/ClearScreen But BEFORE The Users Are Displayed To The Screen, You Can Have The Conference Name From Which The Util Was Run Displayed At The Top Of The Ansi Output. Simply A Yes/No Option. NOTE: I said The Name Of The Conference TConf Was Run FROM. *NOT* The Conference/s You Have Put Into The

ACCESS_AREAS=
ToolType.

1.17 TConf: ToolTypes - PASSWORD

PASSWORD=XXXX....

If TConf Finds This ToolType Present With A Valid Password It Will Ask The User To Input The Correct Password Before It Will Let Him Exit The Util And Proceed Within The Conference. This Is Mainly Here For Those Sysops Who Wish To Run This Door As Soon As A User Has Joined A Private Conference. The Password Can be ANY combination Of Numbers/Letters Etc, Upto A Maximum Limit Of 59 Characters. The Check Made Is NOT Case Sensitive Cause That Only Would Piss Legitimate Users Off! The User Will Be Given 3 Attempts To Enter The Correct Password Followed By Return. If They Fail All 3 Attempts TConf Will Legally Drop Carrier On The User And Notify The Sysop By Leaving A Suitable Comment Attached To The Nodes CallersLog. Ami-Express Will Then Reset The Node And Await The Next Caller.

1.20 TConf: ToolTypes - ONE_TIME_PASSWORD

ONE TIME PASSWORD=YES/NO

This Is A Special PassWord Option. In Order For This To Run Correctly You Will Need To Have An Assigned T: Directory. When A User Logs On And Correctly Gets The PassWord To A Particular Conference A SMALL File In Your T: Dieectory Will Be Created By TConf. If He Rejoins This Same Conf He Will NOT Need To Type In The PassWord Again. TConf Will Keep Track Of ALL Conference PassWords Correctly Accessed By The User And Not Ask For Them A Second Time. This Even Tracks If The User Uses "RL" To Re-Logon Or Simply Calls The Same Node Again Before Any Other Users.

Although A Good Idea (Thanks T.G.R!), This Way Of Doing Things Does Have A slight Problem. If A Hacking User Logs OnTo The Board Straight After The Legitimate User Has Called He Would Have Access To The Protected Conference (DUMB!!). A Simple Way Of Stopping This Problem Is To Delete The File Created In The T: Directory In That Particular Nodes Logoff-Script. So Simply Add To Each Nodes Logoff-Script The Following Line:

DELETE T:TConfUser_NodeX << "X" Is The Node Of The Logoff-Script!!

This Will Mean The User WOULD Be required To Insert The Correct PassWord If He Re-Logs On Or Is The Next Person To Call The SAME Node, And Gets Rid Of The Hacker Problem. I could Have Built This In But It Would Mean You Would Have To Run A Second Util As Your "G" Or "RL" Commands And This Was Thought To Be NOT A Good Idea. (Even If "G" Doors Do Suk In My Books!)

Its A Little Hard To Explain How It Works So Try It Out And See For YourSelf. A Nice Idea, But ,Of Course, Its Only Optional!

If This ToolType Does NOT Exist, Then TConf Will Default To NO.

1.21 TConf: ToolTypes - EXPRESS VERSION

Where "X" Is the MAIN Version Number Of The Express/Express Variant You Are Using. You Have Two Choices For Running TConf. Any Sysop Should Know What \leftarrow They Are.

Simply Have The User Type In Whatever You Have Setup For The Door TO Run. Ie In This Archive They Would Type In "ACCESS" And Be Told What Users Have Access To The Confs Desribed In The ToolTypes. Or You Can Set It Up To Run In An MCI script. For Instance Your NewUsers/Bull100.Txt May Say...

~CC_ACCESS

Which In MCI-Script Language Tells Ami-Express To Run The Door Called ACCESS Rather Than Display This As A text File. Simple Stuff Eh?


