ShowFont requires:

* an Amiga & diskfont.library in drawer LIBS: ;-)

1.4 ShowFont / Use

Use

Using ShowFont is very simple. Simply write:

ShowFont [fontname.font] <size>

Font name must end with ".font". Size is optional. If you don't specify a size, ShowFont will display the font with the lowest one.

If anything goes right, ShowFont will open a window displaying a phrase using the selected font. ShowFont also prints on a CLI window some infos about the font (name, size, lower char, higher char, baseline...).

ShowFont also displays Color fonts in the opened window. At the moment, Color font palette is not supported. ShowFont uses WB palette.

Bugs

At the moment ShowFont has a bug only. This one is caused probably by the compiler because source is really bug free. No gurus, however.

When you quit from ShowFont clicking on the window close gadget, ShowFont doesn't free allocated memory. So, you have to use some commands such as Avail Flush or Flush to recover un-used memory.

Sorry! I'll change the compiler. ;-)
