When one or more tasks refer to the message to be removed
      it is marked as "removed" and cannot be read with QGetMsq()
by other tasks.

All tasks get a chance to read every message in the queue with the possible exception of messages removed with QRemMsg().

necessary to use QReplyMsg() before QGetMsg(). A task which
might block indetermindly should use QReplyMsg() to allow
the originator of it's current message to reclaim it.
