#### 1.4 How to Use Phonebook

PhoneBook is a small utility which is used to keep numbers easy and accesable. PhoneBook requires Courier 13 font installed in the fonts: directory to run properly, if you do not haave it, it is contained in this archive. It is quite easy to run, just type 'PB' from a shell window or click on the icon using WorkBench. PhoneBook opens up a window where, within are six gadgets and a box in the middle with the numbers 1 to 9 running down the side. The buttons in the window do the following:

- Add Entery Allows you to add a phone number into the booklet which will be filed for future use. You will be asked various questions about the entery.
- Del Entery Deletes an entery in the phone book. You will be prompted to enter the number of the entery to delete. Press 'A' here to abort it and go back to the menu. If you want something deleted, press the number of the entery and it will be deleted and all enteries below that point will be moved up.
- More Information The Regular screen shows only Name and Number but when this is pressed, you will be prompted to enter the number of the entery you want to see. Press 'A' here to abort and go back to the menu. When a number is givin, the window will show everything about that entery.

Quit - Exits (Easy, isn't it?)

Up - Goes up one page

Down - Goes down one page
