1.2 welcome

Welcome to the ShadowStart documentation.

Please read this documentation before you use ShadowStart, otherwise you may not understand the purpose and the usage of this tool!

When reading this guide, please remember:
All translation- and typing-errors are intentional
and belong to the whole work of art. ;-))

ShadowStart was developed and carefully tested on my Amiga 3000 (OS 3.1).

1.3 distribution

Since version 1.3 ShadowStart is ANYWARE ;-), this means you MUST send me anything to register ShadowStart, if you want to use it longer than one week (evaluation time).

It's not important what you send me, it can be really anything...
For example a bar of chocolate, any kind of computer items
(how about an A4000T? :-), but a CD-Caddy is always welcome...),
some bucks, a keyfile of a selfmade program, a nice letter, an interesting
postcard or just some lines via EMail.
(All people who wrote to me about a previous version are automatically
registered.)

ShadowStart may be freely distributed as long as no charge is made other than to cover time and copying costs.
This should not be higher than what Fred Fish charges from one of his freely redistributable disks.

The program, documentation and sourcecode must be distributed in their original unmodified form.
Distribution of single parts of the ShadowStart packet is not allowed.

Feel free to use the sourcecode or portions of it in your own programs,

but DO NOT change the sourcecode and redistribute it within this archive under the name ShadowStart!

Distribution via Meeting Pearls CDs, Fred Fish CDs/disks and Aminet CDs/disks is explicitly allowed.

If you would like to distribute ShadowStart together with own programs (especially commercial packages) you need my permission for it!

1.5 purpose

Why did I wrote ShadowStart?

Well, I was sitting in front of my Amiga and trying to start a program, but I didn't get it to run correctly... (ya know this... ;-)
So I tried to start the program after booting without startup-sequence, but this program could only be run from the Workbench... *damn* ;)
But how to load the Workbench without executing any programs in the WBStartup-drawer?

This was the point I got the idea to write a program that pops up a little requester at startup, which lets you select if you want to disable the "WBStartup" drawer and/or the "User-Startup" file!
ShadowStart was born... :-)

As it should be possible to select this on every startup, ShadowStart checks if you pressed the
activation-key
(ie. hold it down during startup) and
then pops up a nice requester asking you what should be disabled.

New for version 1.3 is the automatic validation check. Program execution is delayed until the SYS: partition is validated (See
Usage section
for details).

If you think that ShadowStart would be usefull for you, then look into

part of this documentation on how you can do this...

1.6 requirements

ShadowStart needs:

- any Amiga :-)
- V40 version of ShadowStart needs:
Kickstart/Workbench 3.1
(the 3.1 lowlevel.library must be available)
- V37 version of ShadowStart needs:
Kickstart/Workbench 2.04 or higher
- and a correct
installation
, -)

1.7 installation

Installation is very easy:

- 1) Depending on what Kickstart you use, copy either the 2.0+ or the 3.1 version of "ShadowStart" in any directory you want.
I recommend the "c:" directory.
- 2) Load your "s:Startup-Sequence" into a text-editor and add the following line after the SetPatch-command:
"<path>ShadowStart"
(If it's in your "c:" directory, you must enter "c:ShadowStart".)
- 3) This documentation may copied to the directory,
where you store your guide files.

1.8 usage

If ShadowStart is
installed
correctly the usage is

as follows...

If you want to disable the "WBStartup" drawer or the "User-Startup" file

during startup, then simply hold down the version dependant
 activation-key
 after a reset or after you switched the computer on...
 If ShadowStart notices that the
 activation-key
 is down, it will pop a
 requester, asking you what you want to disable.
 You can select one of the following buttons:

```

WB + User
    (disables both, WBStartup and User-Startup)

WB
    (disables only WBStartup)

User
    (disables only User-Startup)

NewShell
    (opens a shell window)

Cancel
    (you guess what it does... ;-)
```

But what does it mean, when ShadowStart "disables" them?
 Well, it's just simple... ShadowStart renames the WBStartup-drawer and/or
 the User-Startup file to prevent them from being executed! :)
 ("WBStartup"/"WBStartup.info" is renamed to "_WBStartup"/"_WBStartup.info"
 and "User-Startup" is renamed to "_User-Startup")

After startup the drawer and the file stay renamed!
 If you want the original names back, you can either rename them by hand
 or run ShadowStart again.
 But normally there is no need to do this...

If you boot without holding down the
 activation-key
 the WBStartup-drawer and
 the User-Startup file are automatically renamed to their original name!

New for version 1.2:
 With the NewShell-button you can open a shell-window.
 The execution of the startup-sequence is paused until you send a
 'break' to ShadowStart.
 If ShadowStart was executed directly after SetPatch, it has normally
 the process number 1.
 Typing "break 1" in the shell-window will stop ShadowStart and the
 execution of the startup-sequence is continued.
 Don't forget to close the shell-window, so that the Workbench can
 reset the screen (if needed).

New for version 1.3:
 Before any key checks are performed ShadowStart checks if the SYS: partition
 is currently being validated.

If yes, Shadowstart waits 3 seconds and checks the disk state again. When the validation is finished, ShadowStart automatically continues with its normal execution.

The main effect of this feature is that startup execution will be delayed until the SYS: partition is validated (no more disk-trashing on startup).

The validation check is always performed, if the

activation-key

is

pressed or not.

Restrictions: If you press the

activation-key

to early when starting up,

ShadowStart maybe don't recognize that it was pressed!

But this may only happens after a cold-reset

(ie. turning on the computer).

1.9 activation

Since version 1.2 I included an additional ShadowStart version for Kickstart/Workbench 2.0+, but due to key checking under 2.0 I had to change the previous used spacebar as activation-key to something different.

If you use the 2.0+ (V37) version of ShadowStart, you should use either the left or the right ALT key to activate ShadowStart.

If you use the 3.1 (V40) version of ShadowStart, you should use the spacebar to activate ShadowStart.
