1.5 Basics about CheckVal

WHAT DOES IT DO?

This is a small program that is meant to be used at the top of your S:StartUp-Sequence file. It will check if any disks are validating and if so, it will pause the startup until the validation process has finished.

Basically it does the same as this, though a lot faster:

Assign T: RAM:

Info >RAM:Temp

Search > RAM: Temp 2 RAM: Temp Validating

IF NOT "`list RAM:Temp2 Iformat %l`" eq "empty"

Echo "Drive(s) validating..."

CheckVal 3 / 6

Ask "Press <RETURN> to continue boot:"

ENDIF

Delete RAM:Temp#? quiet

This program is extremely useful if you softkick your Kickstart when you boot for the first time (or, as I do, on every boot). If your harddisk is validating and your softkick program resets the machine, you're probably going to have a very bad day cleaning and restoring files. But if this program is one of the first programs in your startup, it will pause the startup procedure until it is safe to continue.

The name of the device that is validating will be shown. The user will then be asked to press enter. You should press enter only after the drive light has gone out completely. If the drive is still validating when the user presses enter, the program will inform about this and ask to press CTRL-C if the user really wants to continue.

CheckVal also has an option to make it check the status of the disks every 5 secs until everything is OK. This is useful for BBS sysops etc.

I had to write this program since my harddisk started crashing a lot while I was testing a Mitsumi FX100D CDROM drive. Must have been that extra long ATID cable I was using...

1.6 What is needed to use CheckVal

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

You'll need an Amiga computer (see compatibility list), with Kickstart 2.04 (intuition.library and gadtools.library version 37 or higher).

A harddisk will be useful.

1.7 What CheckVal runs on

COMPATIBILITY

CheckVal will work on any Commodore-Amiga, running on Kickstart 2.04 or higher. This includes the following: CD32, CDTV, A500(+), A600, A1000, A1200, A2000, A2500/20, A2500/30, A3000/16, A3000/25, A4000/40, A4000/30. The program SHOULD work on any upgrades (based on the Amiga Development Guidelines, see Amiga ROM Kernel Reference Manual (Kickstart 1.3 version): Libraries and Devices, introduction).

1.8 Starting CheckVal from a CLI/Shell

STARTING FROM CLI/SHELL

You can start the program only from CLI/SHELL/etc.

Run the program with the following options from your CLI/SHELL/etc.

1> CheckVal AUTO/S

Where: AUTO makes the program wait until validation has completed

instead of asking the user to press enter.

You should add this line into your S:StartUp-Sequence to run the program when

the machine is booted:

SYS:C/CheckVal

or

SYS:C/CheckVal AUTO

..if you do not want to to wait until a user interacts.

1.9 wbstart

STARTING FROM WORKBENCH

This program cannot be started form Workbench.

1.10 Error messages displayed by CheckVal

ERROR MESSAGES

CheckVal will display necessary error messages. I HATE PROGRAMS

THAT DON'T TELL WHAT-THE-HELL IS GOING ON! That clear? If CheckVal

doesn't give any output, output has been redirected to NIL: etc.

Don't redirect the output unless you really don't want to know which disk is about to go bezerk.

If you try to run the program on a machine that has a Kickstart under 2.04 you won't get an error message. The program will, however, set the return code.
