Descriptions of avaible buttons:

- o INPUT - Select Mpeg input audio file (.MP2)
- o OUTPUT - Select Mpeg decoded output audio file
- o Freq Div - Modify the Freq Div between 1-2-4
- o Quality - Modify the quality between Worst-Best
(Note: Best is avaible in the registered version!)
- o Shift Bit - Implement the output Shift Bit option
- o i - See the "about" window
- o PLAY - Play the current mpeg audio file in standard Amiga 8 bit audio mode.
- o DECODE - Decode input mpeg audio file to output file
- o AIFF option - Use this option to create an AIFF output file
(Note: Avaible only in the registered version!)
- o Mono Output - This option make a MONO output audio file
- o Audio Filter - If active make audio filter ON! This function have effects only when use PLAY mode.

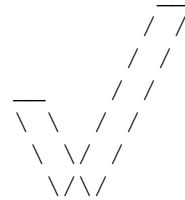
