1.2 What Is CutIT?

CutIT is small and fast utility that will split AmiNet INDEX file, ↔
to many
'smaller' parts. What does it mean?

It will take each 'theme' and 'subtheme', and will create files with names
like...

biz_dbase biz_demo biz_dopus biz_misc

...and will place them in desired directory.

It is usefull for people with less RAM, and less nerves (when You try to search for string "source" i.e., and You find it in every 30th line ;).

Also, if You know WHERE and WHAT to search for, it will be a piece of cake to find it...

I decided to make this, because I had a chance to use similar utility that splitted my INDEX file for 25 minutes(!?) on A4000/040.

- An Amiga
- Kickstart 3.X
- AmiNet INDEX file
- Some MBs on hard disk to place result files in

CutIT was tested on A4000/040 with OS3.0. Haven't tested it on OS2.X yet, but I think it will work fine.

1.4 Installation

Installation is really hard! :)

Copy CutIT#? wherever You want.

You don't know where!? Argh. Go and buy a PC.

1.5 Usage

Syntax is:

CutIT <index file> <directory where you want to place result files>

In example:

6.Temp:SC/CutIT> CutIT dh1:temp/index dh2:Index

In this case, INDEX file is located in dh1:temp, and result files will be created in dh2:Index directory.

Of course, You can do everything in RAM:, it will be a bit faster!

Here are some speed results:

--[Caches ON]--

Index ResultDir

Ram:	Ram:	16.30 sec
dh1:	Ram:	18.74 sec
dh1:	dh2:	23.16 sec

--[Caches OFF]--

Index ResultDir

Ram:	Ram:	92.40 sec
dh1:	ram:	96.62 sec
dh1:	dh2:	96.65 sec

(NOTE: It was tested on A4000/040-25MHz & 18Mb RAM)
