Chapter 1

REVISION.DOC

1.1 Version 0.4 (11-06-96)

Implemented a small Check Routine for the Conferences. Dat File if its not existant then Express will create the required Data File depending on the Information supplied by the ACP.

Dont you love it when you fixed a Bug, tested if the Fix worked and then one Day later you find out that by fixing the other Bug you re-introduced an older one? well this happened just now, the Join Conference Part didnt work anymore if you selected some Conferences for the MailScan Prefs, but NOW it works again! phew!

Fixed a Bug with the MailScan Presets, forgot to give one Variable a Value in case of a normal MailScan, thus the Express would think it was a ReScan and ALWAYS rescan the whole MessageBases/Conferences...

NEW ACP: Thanks to X/\D and Rikki Ratboy we now have a new and slightly updated ACP Controller. You can change the ACP Font and it also has the AppIcon back in there plus a few Bug Fixes. the new ACP Program is available via the update Program, the Information about whats new is available in our Support Conference on Synergy.

Changed the NEW Acp to allow Express change its Screen Font, the new ACP Option is called FONT_NAME . the Format is like this <Fontname.font>/<Size>

e.g:

NODE* FONT_NAME topaz.font/8

will choose the topaz Font for the Express Screen, Size would be 8 Pixels (thats if i am right with that huh huh)

There seems to be a random Bug appearing on some Files Express would ask for a new Filename even tho the old one would fit just fine into the DIR Listings. i'm trying to fix this.. The Fact that this Bug does not appear on a regular Basis does not make it easier. Please tell me if the Bug is still there, thats for those who have encountered it.

Added another User Setting: Selectable MailScan PER CONF! yes, just like on Tempest/Fame/AmiExpress the User can now select in which Conferences he would like to have a MailScan in upon Login, unless he turned it off completely via the Old Mailscan Flag... (The old one will override it)... IF the User wants to scan thru all the Conferences just like he would without this new Feature he can use the "\$" Command for MsgBase ReScanning. The BBS will also scan for Mail if the User joins a Conference where he turned the Scan Feature off. All in all it sums up to this: The Mail Scan Toggles do ONLY work on the initial Mailscan, the one right when he logs in!

Added Support for an external Message Base/Scanner. Express will look for a File called <PathtoConf>MAILSCANNER if found it will first try to execute a Door out of the Conf<x>.cmd File called MAILSCAN, if Express cannot find that Door in there it will try and start the <PathtoConf>MAILSCANNER File as a XIM Door.. just like the BBS:System Files... The Command Line given to the Door is "MAILSCAN"

By fixing the other Bug, i introduced a new one, it would somehow mess up the replies sometimes on a few (well...) Messages, by adding another Return Code behind it, this should be fixed now...

Fixed a Bug in the Messagebase Header, where it wouldnt print out the Date the Mail has been received, and didnt show the Catalog String either.

Fixed a second Bug in the Messagebase were entered Lines would sometimes appear twice if the Fullscreen Editor has been used. Thanks to Data Stream for pointing those Things out and helping with finding the Bug...

from now its not possible anymore to edit the Sysop's Name unless the Sysop does it by himself, should prevent joking CoSysop's from Changing the Sysop's Handle. Idea by Data-Stream.

Fixed a small Bug in the Catalog File, one part of the MSGBase when the Mail was Received it would still have one part left of the old MsgBase Design, this is fixed.

from now on it is not possible anymore to delete Account Slot No.1 (usually the Sysop One) also no one but Account Slot #1 will be able to change Slot #1's User Level, this should add some bit of Security or Pranks made to the Sysop Account.

(based upon an idea by Data-Stream)

in case of a low space situation WHILE someone is uploading express will now skip all files which do not fit on the disk anymore

NOTE: if any of these new Routines do NOT work, let me know asap!

Just email me at siegma@teuto.de ! (its no typo, it IS siegma)

In case the free Amount of Space on the Upload Drive falls below 2 Megabytes, Express will now look for a Script called "BBS:Utils/FreeSpace.script" and execute it, you can place some "Automatic Make more Upload Room" Program in there, such as "OffLine V1.14 by AIRWOLF" ((c)1991:)) to let the BBS automatically take care of the Free Upload Bytes Stuff.. you could aswell use some Automatic Move Utility as the one done by SNARF a few Years ago. However i dont have that one, but those who would like to have the OFFLINE Tool, let me know...
Besides that: The script will only be run asynchronous, like you would issue the RUN Command to it. The User will get a Message telling him to try uploading again in a few Minutes..

Fixed a Bug for Guys converting from AmiExpress to s!x:

The Languages would cause a Lock Error on Users who are still with the old AmiExpress Structures, this has been fixed.

Fixed a Bug with the Conference Password handling, wasn't working correctly anymore after i altered the Way Express handles the Conference.dat File.

it should now be possible to make s!x resident. this somehow has brought a small limitation (not for long tho):
The MessageBase's has been a bit reduced, only 80 Lines and 76 Chars per Line allowed, opposed to the older Version where it was possible to have 100 Lines and 200 Chars per Line (ANSI/FULLED)

Everyone feel free to test it, also you DO require the Conferences.Dat File now. This is mandatory! To create this File (if you dont already have it!) simply go to the Account Editor and enter 'c' then press Return It should now save the Conferences.Dat File to the BBS: Directory.

Been working the past few Days on the Catalog Mainly, this is NOT the Release Version but i found it adequates(sp) to change the Version String to the long awaited 0.40, the 0.40(release) Version should be out very soon, not sure when tho.

Whats new:

Fixed a Bug with the Sysop Download Functions not allowing Downloads of more than *i dont know how many* , just that the String Array it used for it was a BIT too short (100 Bytes) the Array now is 1Kbyte long. Let me know if it still gives Problems

MORE Catalog Strings, i hope to have found most of them, report those that are still missing to me, thanks!

Thats about it really... besides that it's been my lazyness holding most of the new Stuff back, NOTE: THE FTP OPTION SHALL COME LATER ON, i figured out thats its a bigger Project than it looked like a first (need to make a FTP Server for the BBS, so people can use their Accounts without a Hassle)

Thats about it for the Moment, stay tuned!

1.2 Version 0.39z9 (PreRelease) (08-26-96)

For all the Folks of you out there that were hassling me:

(Hi to Data-Stream, MDR and the Rest of the UK Folks :))

Conference Accounting has been expanded by the Ratios per Conference Feature, stay tuned a bit more for more Comfort in that Direction as the Account Editor is still a bit too ...simple.. (IMHO) Plus the Ratio per Conference setting cannot be setup using the ACP.Startup YET, should come within this/the next few Days...

To activate the Ratio per Conference simply Edit the User you wish to have this Feature activated on, then choose the 'T' Option (Conference Accounting) and use the new '3' Option to activate it Do NOT forget to use the 'Z' Option in the Account Editor to EDIT the Conference Ratios, else it'll use the normal Default Ones.

Before i forget it: The Conference's Ratio's TYPE (File/Byte/File&Byte) is still handled GLOBALLY. If required i will change it to be set up differently in the Conferences too.

Removed a serious bug with Smodem/Hydracom Transfers

If a File (or a few Files) smaller than the Sum of 4K would have
been uploaded, Express would have caused a Zero Divide Error, this
is fixed now.. sort of fixed:).. well it'll say 1 cps, but who cares?

Another Bug Fix (probably a Bug!) - if setting up a external/different Playpen Directory for the Files AND using Noisy Belch's Background Checker the Files would most probably be moved to the Upload Dirs but also moved to the PartUpload Dirs, this SHOULD be fixed now, found out that i wasn't checking for the external/different Playpen Dir in one Part of the

MoveToUploadDir

Routine, changed that and hope it'll work, i'll test it later on tho.

1.4 Version 0.39z7 (ALPHA) (08-12-96)

Working on FTP Upload Possibilities, its already working but still very Beta if not ALPHA, currently we have no FTP Downloads and also no DUPE CHECKING (if the File has already been uploaded OR is currently been uploaded) i will have to work on the new FTP DAEMON (yes!) a bit to get that to work too, also the ftp daemon does NOT use the user.data from Express yet (as said, very EARLY Version) you can check it out on my BBS if you're connected to the Net. Contact me first on IRC tho as i will have to set up a few Things. Else enjoy!

1.5 Version 0.39z6 (08-07-96)

OLM.Message.Txt will now also be displayed if the User selected 'Q'uick Logoff at the Transfer Start. Before it would drop Carrier on him without displaying that File. (Suggested by Noisy Belch)

1.6 Version 0.39z5 (07-21-96)

Okay, Data-Stream actually found a BUG in the Revision.Doc (first Time, hopefully the last one too.. apart from forgetting to include Links)

The File that is going to be displayed when a User had a Hack Attempt on his Account is NOT called BBS:BBSTEXTS/HACK.TXT but instead its BBS:BBSTexts/HackED.txt - Sorry for any Inconvience!

Interphase reported a small "Flaw" where Express would not show the "Sysop is selecting Files..." Text to the User, this is fixed now.

Express will now show a Text File called Hack.Txt in the BBSTexts Directory in case of an Hack Attempt, should be more visible than just a String. If the text File is not available, Express will just show the usual

"There was a Hack Attempt" String to the User and Pause. (Suggested by Data-Stream)

Changes some Parts of the Upload/Download Routine, so that if a User did choose 'Q'uick Logoff or 'G'oodbye after Transfer and ABORTED the Upload, he would get back to the normal Prompt, instead of getting thrown out like it used to be before... most of the Time on such Cases the User forgot to do something, or wanted to flag another File, so from now on he can do it without having the need to call back...

Fixed a Bug in the Attach a File Part, simply didnt recognise any File that you have selected with the Requester anymore.

Changed the String "<suppressed>" to "<encrypted>" in the New User and User's Account Editor Section, confused a few People (especially English speaking ones, my Fault - sorry!). THANKS to Data-Stream for letting me know.

1.8 Version 0.39z3 (07-16-96)

New Option for the ACP.Startup File:

NODE<x> RINGCOUNTS <y>

<x> = The Node Number or '*' for ALL Nodes

<y> = The Amount of RING's before the Node should send the Answer String
 to the Modem. Should be useful in some Cases (e.g. Telnet Nodes with
 Problems of answering an incoming Call, weird Phoneline Problems etc)

Note: You also need the new ACP - Note #2: You HAVE to set the RINGCOUNTS in the ACP.StartUp File!!

Fixed a Bug with the ASCII Send Function (Shift-F4) - was trying to find a File with a Space added behind. Works again now.

Btw: The '5' Command seems broken too (slightly), in the meantime just use '5 <directory path>' instead. Same goes for '2' (so i heard...).

Just checked the '2' Command, works fine on my End, People may try to check if they actually have a NodeO Directory, i think if it doesnt exist it would abort/skip the Rest... Note to myself: Need to change the Routine for that 2!

Implemented a new MCI Command Sequence: ~SQ_<Filename>|

Will show the specified Filename in nonstop Mode. Needs to be tested first tho.

Added something else (well, not my own Idea tho..:)):

If a User enters his Password false for the 3rd Time it will set a Flag
in the User Data, next Time he calls he will only have ONE Try to enter
his PW correctly, if he succeeds he will be notified that there was a
Hack Attempt on his Account and the Flag will be reset. (Courtesy Tempest BBS)

Express is now searching for ENV:ByeBye.<NodeNumber> instead of
BBS:Node<x>/ByeBye - Programmers please change it, Tests have proven
that it is better to have these Files in ENV: than in BBS:Node<x>
(less Disk Activity on Uploads)

1.10 Version 0.39z1 (07-12-96)

Fixed a Bug in the Temporary Account Editor. Simply didnt set the OLD Access Flags back to where they belong, thus temporary giving a User a 255 would result in the User still having 255 even if you pressed SHIFT+F6 to remove the temporary Stats. This is fixed now! Thanks to Data Stream for telling me how it exactly works, btw: if you ran a PW Door to protect the SysOp Options the Bug didnt have any Effect, except for the MsgBase Editing Part (bad enough still)

Put a new F-Key in there... -> Zmodem Download. the F-Key is SHIFT+F3 and may be used whenever a User is online on the Node you press the Key on, it will pop up an ASL Requester asking for a File to download - this is sort of a replacement/enhancement of the Sysop Download Function, much safer too :)

Fixed a Bug with the Keyboard Input Routines (i Think i did..) which would cause a Node to literally hang if a User used one of the following Keycombo's: Shift-TAB, Shift-CursorUP, Shift-CursorDOWN, Shift-CursorRIGHT and Shift-CursorLEFT .. this should not happen anymore, BUT let me know if the new Routine gives you any Problem!

1.11 Version 0.39z (07-11-96)

If you equipped a Conference with a Password using the Conferences.Dat Data File and the Conference Editor / Door, Express will now skip the Password Question at the MailScan, the User will actually have to join into that Conference.

1.12 Version 0.39y9 (07-10-96)

Changed the Routine where Express is looking for the Ami_Drives File, if the Ami_Drives file is nonexistant, Express would have stopped the User from uploading, from now on it will assume that the only Drive available is the one where the BBS is located on, thats if the Ami_Drives File is missing.

Fixed a Bug with the ZModem Protocol, if a User would download a File which is already bigger in Size on HIS Side the Express would crash, now it will just abort the Transfer or try to continue with the next File in the Users Batch List.

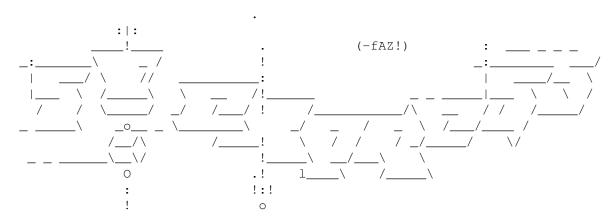
