This transformation was combined with the action ;../Actions/Morphology.rtf; ↪ **Morphology/Erosion** to make the letters a little thinner. The ;../Compositing.rtf; ↪ **Compositing** method used was ;../Compositing.rtf;brighter; ↪ **Brighter** to copy only white pixels. Intensity was switched to 60% to make the white letters on the red background slightly transparent.

The guy standing in front of the rock has been removed with a technique called Cloning. This was done by drawing one transformation arrow from an area having the desired surface texture into the area that is to be removed. For this purpose, as in many

other cases, the Identity action has been used. Identity is an action based on the ;../Actions/Channel Conversion.rtfd;;- **Channel Conversion** action that does not change the pixel. Thus a copy of the pixel will be made by the Transformation.
