

## **Corporate Backgrounder**

The groupware paradigm originally sought to improve the productivity of workgroups on a network. But the benefits of first-generation groupware products have often appealed more to organizations than to individuals. The result of this disparity is that, because individual users receive few direct benefits from using these products, they aren't motivated to use them. Thus, the only way to realize an actual productivity gain from most groupware applications has been to issue a mandate from the top requiring people to use them.

Sarrus takes a different approach.

Sarrus provides group-oriented applications that are so compelling that individual users can't live without them. We achieve this end by careful choice of leveraged applications, next-generation user interface design, and extensive testing of prototypes in the field. With a sufficient user base, the group-oriented capabilities of the software come into play. Group scheduling, for example, requires a 50% minimum penetration rate within the user base, the point at which users naturally begin to share scheduling information and improve their work processes.
