INSTALLATION

To install your registered version of Wheel of Luck, create subdirectory on your hard drive (i.e. WOL) and copy the files from the diskette to this subdirectory. copy the file VBRUN200.DLL to this same subdirectory or your Windows System subdirectory.

If you have other programs that require VBRUN200.DLL, it is better to put one copy of it in your Windows System subdirectory rather than have multiple copies on your hard drive.

To start Wheel of Luck, you can double-click on WOL.EXE in the File Manager, or define a Program Item in the Program Manager. From the Program Manager, choose File/New/Program-Item then use Browse to find the WOL.EXE file. The icon will appear in the current program group.

This program will NOT alter any of your Windows files. I have tried a lot of Shareware programs that write to the WIN.INI and other files, and it's always difficult to locate everything to remove them. So, I wrote this game to be self-contained within its' own subdirectory.

Read the README.TXT files for information on starting and playing Wheel of Luck. You can use Notepad to read it.

FREE UPGRADES

I have built-in a way for you to self-register all future Shareware versions you might find on your local BBS. When first run it will display the usual Shareware screen with a REGISTER button. Press this button and enter your name and serial number EXACTLY as shown above. If you enter these correctly, the program will create a small ID file which will make it registered, and you will no longer get the Shareware messages.
