

For studying the Compositional Distance method in eukaryotic proteins, one can follow an alternative to the default Cyt/Ext scale. The file should include three lines :

- 1) The first line should contain the values for the Cytoplasmic weight.
- 2) The second line should contain the values for the External weight.
- 3) The third line should contain the values for the SD weight.

The values in each line should be separated by a space. A carriage return should mark the end of line (EOL).
