

•Frequently Asked Questions

Q: I've lost/forgotten the password I was using, what can I do?

A: If you lose or forget your password for GTS, simply reinstall a new copy - the default password, "**Griffin**" will be reinstated (For this reason, it's a good idea to keep your install disk out of reach of students). Note that you will need to re-enter your registration information.

Q: Um, ... I lost my registration form...

A: No problem. Just contact me by email, paper mail, or telephone and I will mail you a new copy of your registration information.

Q: Why is the instructor's view so boring compared to the student's view?

A: This is intended as a security feature. In the event that a student ever manages to gain access to the instructor's view this feature makes it a bit easier to spot from across the room.

Q: I notice that GTS never asks students to save their results. Will the results be lost if a student quits the GTS application before I can save the test?

A: No. In order to make GTS as easy as possible for students of all ages to use, GTS automatically saves the students' test results as soon as they click on the "Done" button.

Q: I'd like to see you add _____ .

A: Drop me a note either by email or paper mail. If enough people express an interest (or if I just think it sounds really neat) I may add it.

Q: How do I change the order of the questions within a test?

A: There is no way to directly rearrange the order of question from within GTS. If you need to put questions in a specific order you may want to write out your questions and answers using a text editor, then use Copy and Paste to place your questions in the Test Editor in the desired order.
