

CHAPTER TWO: WHAT'S NEW IN VERSION 1.1?

WHAT'S NEW IN ACME MOVERS 1.1?

- “Droplets” (mini-applications) to allow quick and easy access to Move, Copy, Move & Alias or Delete modes for file transfers — without having to change your control settings or change settings “on the fly.” (See [Chapter 5, “Acme Droplets.”](#))
- Optional log files for logging all operations. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings”](#) and [Chapter 9, “Log File Preferences.”](#))
- Optional confirmation dialog lets Acme Movers tell you what it transferred where. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings.”](#))
- Acme Movers now allows you to set up to ten “Preset” folders that are always only a command-key equivalent away, no matter how deeply nested. (See [Chapter 6, “Using Presets.”](#))
- One Preset (or the Trash) can be set as a “Default” location, allowing automatic transfers to that folder. (See [Chapter 6, “Using Presets.”](#))
- Multiple groups of Presets may be saved and later re-opened for added flexibility. (See [Chapter 6, “Using Presets.”](#))
- Optional password protection of control settings. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings”](#) and [Chapter 8, “Setting Password Preferences.”](#))
- Optional “Expert” file dialogs allow creating new folders, duplicating items, renaming items and trashing items — all without leaving the file dialog. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings.”](#))
- Groups of files and/or folders dropped on Acme Movers may now be transferred “as a group” or transferred to individual destinations. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings.”](#))
- The “Splash screen” now has a status display to let you determine at a glance whether logging, confirmation and auto-transfer are on or off, whether Standard or Expert file dialogs will be used, whether your control settings are “locked” or “unlocked,” and which Presets file is currently being used. (See [Chapters 6-9.](#))
- You specify whether Acme Movers will “beep” to inform you when copy operations are completed. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings.”](#))
- You decide whether Acme Movers stays open or automatically quits after a drop-launch operation. (See [Chapter 7, “General Control Settings.”](#))

NOTE: This does not apply when using the droplets; Acme Movers always automatically quits after performing any transfers requested by the droplet.

- Serial number protection. You have 21 days to look at Acme Movers and decide if you

want to keep it. At the end of 21 days, if you still haven't registered, Acme Movers will lock you out until you send your registration fee and receive a serial number to re-activate it. (So don't forget to send your registration fee!)
