

About Mactracker for Mac OS X

Mactracker provides detailed technical information on every Apple Macintosh model along with information on Apple displays, printers, scanners, digital cameras, the iPod, Newtons, and Mac OS versions. A built-in update engine insures the database is always up-to-date.

Requirements

- Power Macintosh computer
- Mac OS X 10.1 or later
- 10 MB of hard disk space
- Internet connection for update and web based functionality

Known Issues

- If Mactracker crashes when minimizing windows, you need to re-install the application.
- You can only install Mactracker on Mac OS Extended (HFS+) volumes
- Mactracker currently cannot import information from the Internet preferences when signing up for Mactracker News.
