

Editing Team Stats

The standard method of modifying player stats in Head Office uses the master file of all Stats, the HO file. In some cases, you may want to adjust not the master stat file but only one teams stat file.

This section describes how you would do that. Beware, I suggest you do a backup BEFORE you try any of these suggestions. Its easy to make a mistake and like all mistakes, they will tend to compound.

Carefully read the information in this section and they try it on a sample league to see how it works. The skull and cross bones is an adequate symbol for this editing mode.

Why?

You may alter the stats for individual players on a team at any time. One of the most probable reasons you would have for wanting to do this would be to backdate a missed transaction.

Use the Player Transact option from the Navigator and select the team and the player you wish to work with. Once the player name is highlighted, hold down the "shift" key and "E". You will now be able to edit player stats through the HACK Player Info window.

The following shows a HACK Player Info window of a player that has been on a team's roster since the beginning of the season.

s you can see, the top line of stats are all zeros.

Picked up After Season Start

The following shows a HACK Player Info window of a player that was picked after the start of the season.

ote that there are numbers appearing in the top line of player statistics.

These numbers reflect the player stats prior to his placement on the current team. These stats are subtracted from the player YTD (Year to Date) stats found in the master stat HO file to yield the stats found in the second line of player statistics. This second line of player statistics are the stats that count towards team totals. In this instance, the player YTD stats would be AB 143, R 12, H 30, HR 0, RBI 4, SB 0, TB 32.

To change the player stats that will count for a team, you must tab over to the stats on the top row you wish to edit. Make changes in all stat fields in the top row as required. Click on the HACK button to implement changes. You will see that the second row of stats changes automatically.

Waived or Traded Away

The following shows a Hack Player Info for a player that is no longer on the team because he has been traded or waived away.

he stats shown are the stats he has acquired for the team before he was waived or traded.

Tab over to the stats you wish to edit and change them. Remember, you must click on the HACK button or no changes will take place. Whatever stats are shown are the stats that count towards team totals.
