Internet Utilities - operate on selected text. Useful for e-mail and on the web.

<u>URL Extractor - replaces all selected or copied text with all url's within that text.</u>

<u>Eddress Extractor - replaces all selected or copied text with all e-mail addresses within that text.</u>

E-mail Comment - adds the comment character to every line of text.

E-mail Uncomment - removes the comment character from every
line of text. Additionally the text will be reformatted if the option
key is pressed when you select e-mail Uncomment.

E-mail Mask Symbols and Diacritics - changes all special text characters to a presentation in standard ASCII (0-127) which is readable on all systems. For example, curly quotes are changed to straight quotes.

E-mail Wrapper 60 Chars - wraps text at a length of sixty characters. Handy for cleaning up those e-mails that need resending. You can use the Paragraph Maker (text tool) to unwrap textlines.

E-mail Indenter 5 spaces - Indents text with five spaces and wraps the lines after sixty characters. If you hold down the option key when using this utility, it will use ten spaces to indent the text.

Rot 13 - makes normal text unreadable by applying a simple form of encryption which is sometimes used in Usenet postings. If Rot 13 is used again, you will get back the original text.

Styled Text to HTML... - formats text for use on the Web. It recognizes styles, paragraphs and diacritics.

HTML Unmask Symbols and Diacritics - replaces all special HTML characters with a readable Mac character set.
