

Below is a list of changes that have been made to Now Utilities 4.0.1 and 4.0.1p.

Installer

- The Installer properly installs the Sample Catalog and Movie files.
- The Installer no longer updates PictureBook+ if it is found.
- The Installer allows for network installations when all components and the Installer are in the same folder.
- The Install has better error-checking when certain files are not found.

Now Scrapbook

- Now Scrapbook now opens and converts SmartScrap™ files.
- Now Scrapbook now releases all allocated memory after quitting.

Now Profile

- The initial settings in the Now Profile Preferences dialog box have been changed so that only System, CPU, Memory, Drivers, and Extensions information are selected.
- Now Profile is now compatible with Complete Undelete™.
- Now Profile recognizes and lists extensions that load before Now Toolbox.

WYSIWYG Menus

- Double-clicking in certain areas of the control panel no longer causes a system error.
- Menu pull-down is no longer delayed when WYSIWYG Menus is installed.
- WYSIWYG Menus handles larger numbers of installed fonts more efficiently.
- WYSIWYG Menus handles low disk space more effectively.
- The WYSIWYG Menus Prefs file handles the occurrence of damaged fonts more smoothly. You should be prompted if WYSIWYG Menus encounters a damaged font.

Now Toolbox

Changes in 4.0.1

- Now Toolbox now loads at the same time as other extensions. In order to ensure that it loads early in the startup process, Now Toolbox now has two (2) spaces before its name; however, an extension or control panel which requires “first-load” status can be placed before Now Toolbox 4.0.1 simply by typing spaces at the front of its name so that it comes before Now Toolbox alphabetically. Items configured to load before Now Toolbox will not be recognized by Startup Manager, and as a result they will not be listed in the Startup Manager control panel.
- The Now Toolbox Prefs file contains a database of recent files and folders. Now Toolbox 4.0 tended to track all recent files, including preference and supporting files not directly opened or launched by the user, causing these files to be displayed in lists of recent files displayed by NowMenus and Super Boomerang. Now Toolbox 4.0.1 no longer tracks files like these when they are located in the System Folder, which is their most common location. Some supporting files are located in less-obvious areas, however, so you may notice a few of these files still being added to lists of recent items. In general, the overall number should be much smaller. Super Boomerang has also been modified so that it does not pass on supporting-type file information to

the Now Toolbox Prefs file.

- Now Toolbox 4.0.1 no longer requires the presence of the System 7 Tuner 1.1.1 in order to load at startup. However, we recommend that this extension be used, since it

was developed by Apple to correct problems in System 7.0 and 7.0.1. It also helps the system software manage low memory situations better.

- Deleting keyboard shortcuts in applications is more effective. Please note that keyboard shortcuts apply to those applications that use standard menu definitions. If you find that an application is having difficulty with keyboard shortcuts or custom menu font settings, you may elect to exclude it using the "Exclude..." button in the NowMenus Preferences dialog box.
- Arrow keys now also require a modifier key in order to be used as keyboard shortcuts.
- The pathname display (activated by pressing "P" or "W" while highlighting a filename in a menu) now appears properly on black-and-white monitors.
- Launching aliases of desk accessories, no matter where they are located on the hard disk, now functions properly.
- Compatibility problems with Quark Xpress and Aldus Freehand have been resolved.

Changes in 4.0.1p

- Displays folders that reside on AppleShare volumes. You are now able to add Permanent Folders to menus that reside on AppleShare volumes.
- Properly creates and opens more than one workset. Now Toolbox will no longer open the first workset no matter how you try to open more recent worksets.

Startup Manager

- The following file types are recognized by Startup Manager:
INIT, cdev, RDEV, cbnd, fbnd, tbnd, adev, ddev, appe, fext, pext, vbnd
- Accommodates the "stutter restart" generated by MAXIMA, Virtual and MODE32.
- Deleting the first two Links no longer causes a system error.
- Compatibility problems with DataClub have been resolved.

NowMenus

- An EXCLUDE feature has been added to the Preferences dialog box. If you experience difficulties in setting keyboard shortcuts or menus don't look the way you think they ought to, you may wish to exclude the application from NowMenus customization. To do so, click "Preferences..." in the NowMenus control panel, then click "Exclude...", select the application and click "Open." When you exclude an application from NowMenus customization, you are preventing NowMenus from applying a custom menu font or any custom keyboard shortcuts to the application's menus.
- The following functions can now be enabled or disabled in the Preferences dialog box:
 - Application substitution
 - Automatic Memory Sizer when memory is low
- An option for drawing icons in color in all menus has been added to the Preferences dialog box. NOTE THAT THIS OPTION USES A LOT OF SYSTEM MEMORY, typically 100 to 200K.
- An option for displaying only permanent applications in launch menus and permanent files in application submenus has been added to the Preferences dialog box. If you were a user of MultiMaster from version 3.0, and find that you wish NowMenus acted more like MultiMaster, you will want to try this option.
- Compatibility and menu display difficulties with Microsoft Word have been resolved by excluding NowMenus from Word automatically.
- Functionality issues with CE Software's CEIAC™ and worksets have been resolved.

- Palette-type menu functionality in Aldus Persuasion, FileMaker Pro, MacWrite II, and Canvas has been restored.
- Compatibility issues with Timbuktu have been resolved.

- NowMenus now works around a file system bug in Virex.
- NowMenus is now compatible with Thunder 7.
- Microsoft Mail compatibility problems have been resolved. In particular, closing MS Mail and then choosing another item from the Apple menu no longer causes problems.
- MenuFonts now works with NowMenus running.
- Compatibility problems with TypeIt4Me have been resolved.
- Compatibility problems with PopChar and the typing or insertion of special characters (á, ã) have been resolved.
- Compatibility problems with Nisus have been resolved.
- Compatibility problems with Microsoft Works have been resolved.
- Printing to a PostScript file no longer causes a system error.
- All menus (NowMenus pull-down and regular menus) drop without a mouse click when both “Automatically pull menus” and “No click needed” are selected.
- Deleting keyboard shortcuts in applications is more effective. Please note that keyboard shortcuts apply to those applications that use standard menu definitions. If you find that an application is having difficulty with keyboard shortcuts or custom menu font settings, you may elect to exclude it using the “Exclude...” button in the NowMenus Preferences dialog box.
- Arrow keys now also require a modifier key in order to be used as keyboard shortcuts.
- The pathname display (activated by pressing “P” or “W” while highlighting a filename in a menu) now appears properly on black-and-white monitors.
- Launching aliases of desk accessories, no matter where they are located on the hard disk, now functions properly.

NowSave

The following changes have been made in NowSave 4.0.1:

- NowSave’s Key Capture function no longer captures pasted text when it is turned off.
- NowSave better handles the auto-deletion of Saved Work files after Key Capture has been turned off for an extended time and then turned back on.

Super Boomerang

Changes in 4.0.1

- The following options have been added to the Preferences dialog box:
 - Add volume name to file list
 - Clear Temporary Files and Folder on restart
- The Groups feature has been re-implemented in version 4.0.1. Please refer to the Now Utilities Manual Addendum for further information.
- Compatibility problems with Aldus Freehand, Quark Xpress, FileMaker Pro and WordPerfect in Open and Save dialog boxes have been resolved.
- Compatibility problems with MasterJuggler have been resolved.
- Super Boomerang no longer causes an application to quit unexpectedly when you are using the Edit dialog box.
- Super Boomerang Extractor is now compatible with 68000-class Macintoshes.
- Super Boomerang now properly opens Adobe Illustrator files from the DirectOpen submenu.
- Super Boomerang will generate a system beep when it creates, or when it cannot locate, its Preferences file.

Changes in 4.0.1p

- Compatibility issues addressed for newer model Macintosh computers. The hierarchical menus (Super Boomerang menu under the Apple Menu and DirectOpen menu) now display properly on Performas, IIVx, Duos, PB180, etc.
- The Auto relaunch feature works on faster machines.
- Occasional disappearance of hierarchical menus.
- No longer crashes when using Wipe Info from Norton Utilities.
