## What is ClipboardSharing?

ClipboardSharing is a menu extra that allows you to send the contents of your clipboard to the clipboard of other Mac OS X computers. You can use it to send/share almost anything that can be copied to a clipboard, including formatted text and images, and because it uses Rendezvous to find computers on the local network it is very simple and efficient to use. Since it is designed as a menu extra it doesn't take much desktop space and it's always available.

With ClipboardSharing you can also restore previos clipboards; a simple approach to get multiple clipboards. You choose how many recent clipboards you want the application remember, and then you can restore them by using a simple menu. It can save the clipboards to disk when it quits, so that the recent clipboards are available even after a reboot.

## **Requirements**

- A computer running Mac OS X version 10.2 or later (but only tested on 10.2.5)
- To share your clipboard with others you need a TCP/IP network connection

#### Cost

ClipboardSharing is Freeware, wich means you can use it for free as much you want. I will, however, gladly accept donations of any kind. If you want to donate, i recommend that you use PayPal (http://www.paypal.com). Use erik@lagercrantz.cjb.net as the recipient's email with PayPal (or follow the link from my web site). Please contact me if you want to donate in another way. I am a student without a steady income, and donations will help fund further development of ClipboardSharing and other applications.

#### Usage

I believe the basic functions of ClipboardSharing are quite self-explanatory, so I haven't written any documentation. Just launch ClipboardSharing on every computer you want to be able to send or receive clipboards. When you launch it a scissors icon will appear on the right side of your menubar. Clicking on this icon shows a menu from which all the application's functions are available. Be sure to take a look at the options available in the Preferences (accesible from the menu I just mentioned) so that you don't miss something important.

- Fixed a couple of crashing bugs
- No longer shows an error message after downloading an empty clipboard

- Incompatible with previous versions of ClipboardSharing

### Version 1.0.1 beta (released April 5, 2003)

- Fixed a bug that made the application hang when it should show a password dialog
- No longer ignores new clipboards for the previous clipboards menu while it is connecting or transferring a clipboard
- Fixed a bug in size-checking of clipboard data
- Fixed a bug that could potentially cause random crashes
- You can now disable size-checking of clipboard data to improve performance
- More Tool Tip help
- A lot of language and interface fixes
- ClipboardSharing now refuses to quit during a clipboard transfer
- Internal protocol changes (makes ClipboardSharing incompatible with previous versions)
- More text is shown in the previos clipboards menu
