Modification: Now freeware.

Version 1.1.9 - April 16th, 2003

New Feature: Added character overview window.

New Feature: Added toolbar widget.

Bug Fix: Properly draws all characters in the Font Details window, even if in a different encoding.

Bug Fix: Activate Folder of Fonts MENU ITEM now searches all sub folders like it should. Drag & drop a folder onto Font Pilot still worked properly.

Version 1.1.8 - April 16th, 2003

New Feature: Now shows the font name in the font list as well as the font name in its font.

New Feature: Can now drag a folder of fonts onto the application. All sub folders will also be searched.

New Feature: Added Octal and Binary values to the Font Information window. **New Feature:** Added Macintosh and IBM/Windows/PC key combinations for each character in a font.

Enhancement: Print engine GREATLY improved.

Enhancement: Searching the font list works just like it does in the Finder's toolbar Search.

Enhancement: Decreased loading time.

Enhancement: Error reporting more accurate and occurs more often when needed. **Bug Fix:** No longer crashes if the file name is invalid when activating a folder of fonts.

Bug Fix: Hex now returns the hex value of the character instead of the Octal.

New Feature: Added toolbar to the main window.

New Feature: Double click product in updates checker for web url.

Modification: Search box moved to the toolbar.

Modification: Search no longer displays message if no results, but beeps instead. **Modification:** Some menu items renamed to better comply with Aqua HIG.

Modification: Bold, Underline, and Italic buttons changed into Checkboxes and moved to top of window.

Bug Fix: Fixed possible crash if a corrupt font was present and one was scrolling through the font list.

Bug Fix: Shouldn't cut off the last font on a page when printing.

Bug Fix: Now properly sets the background color for text.

Bug Fix: Didn't activate the absolute last font in a folder, if the user chose: Activate Folder of Fonts.

New Feature: Click a font in the main list and hit the delete key to temporarily remove it until you relaunch Font Pilot, or add new fonts to your system using the Activate feature.

Bug Fix: Registration system was broken in the last release, it has now been fixes. Thanks to all of you who registered, and your patience.

Major Enhancement: Displays ALL fonts within the Font Pilot's scope, including hidden ones!

New Feature: Search field.

New Feature: Copy option in the Font Details window.

New Feature: Enable an uninstalled font.

New Feature: Resize bar in middle of window.

New Feature: Added activate entire folder.

New Feature: Scrollwheel support.

New Feature: Window menu added.

New Feature: Preferences (window locations, font colors, etc.) are now saved.

New Feature: Displays up to 512 ASCII values per font.

New Feature: Displays text encoding in the Details window.

Modification: Can now change colors by the ovals in the main window.

Modification: Product Updates window moved into the Preferences window.

Modification: Printing enhanced and bugs corrected.

Modification: If encoding does not match Mac Roman, the Font will be used to display the font name below the list.
