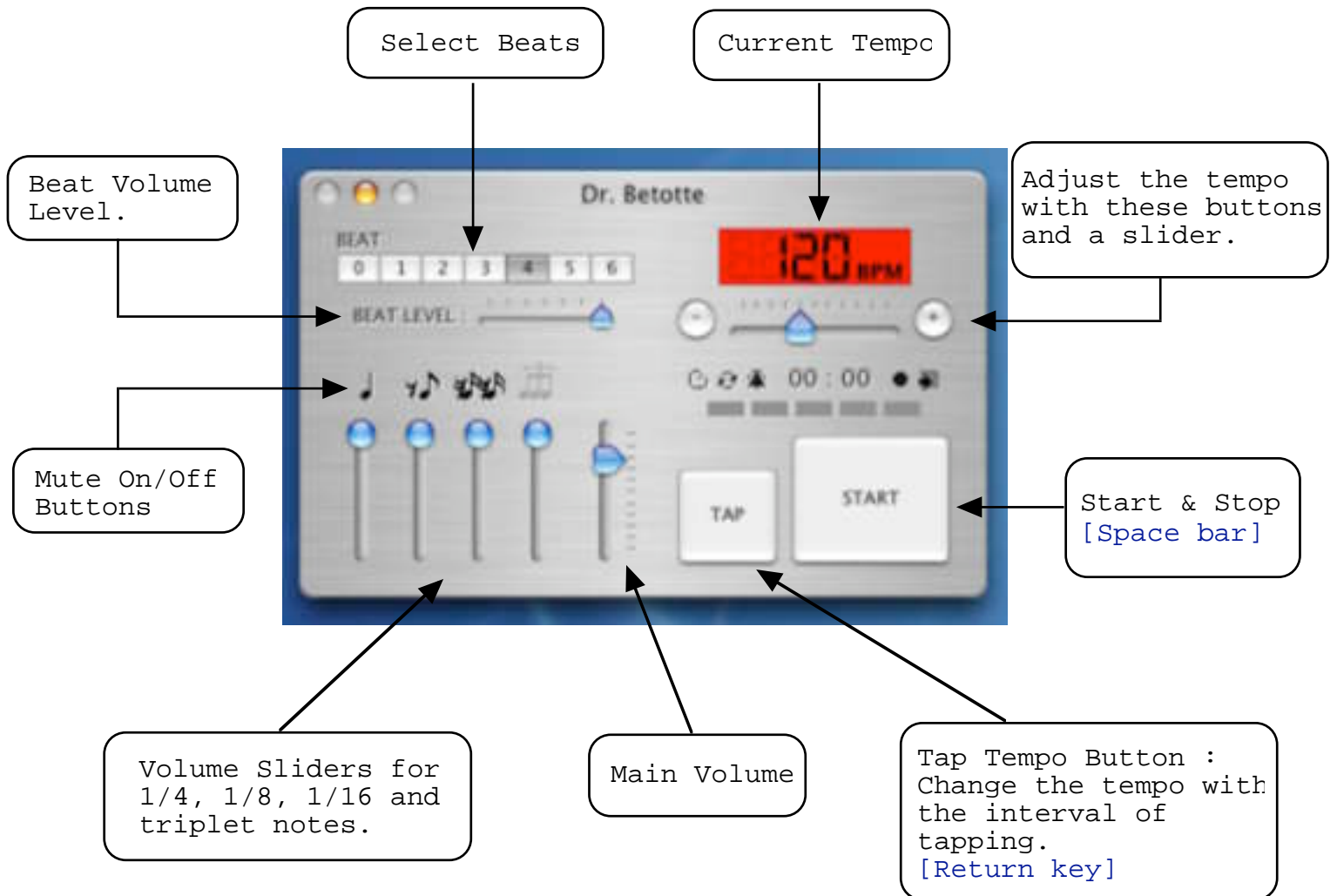


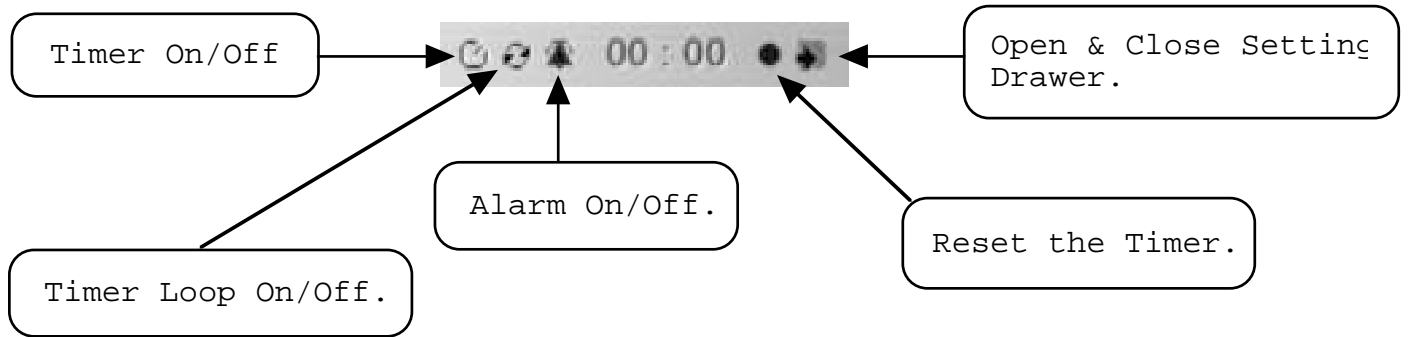
Dr. Betotte Manual

Dr. Betotte is a very easy to use metronome software for Mac OSX. It has 5 volume sliders for 1/4, 1/8, 1/16, Triplet and Beat notes, and uses 5 different sound for each individual notes. Furthermore, you can import your audio-sample files (AIFF) to the program, so that you can make your own click-sets with your favorite sounds. In addition, you can save up to 16 of your settings and recall them by one click.

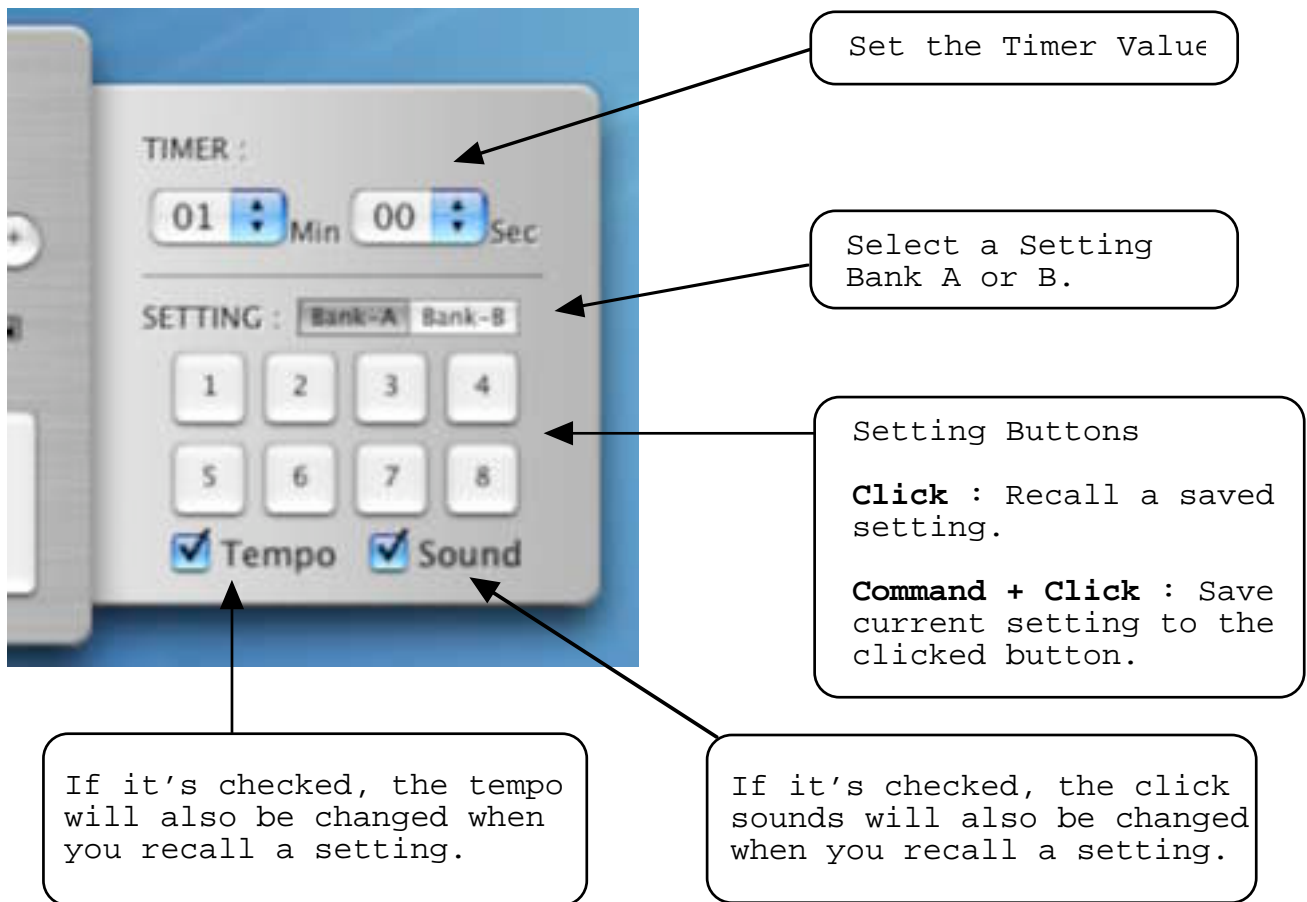
Dr. Betotte also has an alarm timer. It loops and rings an alarm with your specified interval while the metronome is running.

Setting Drawer

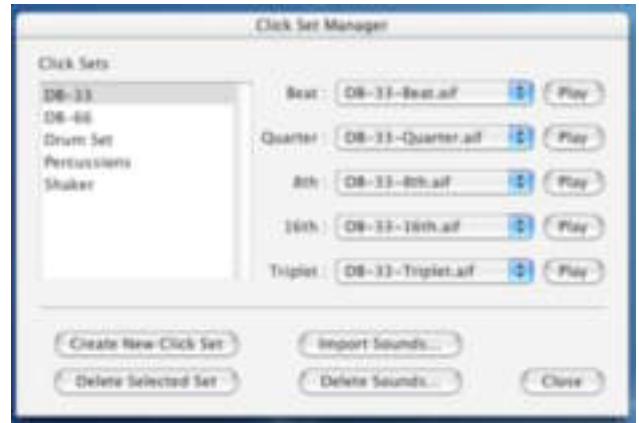


Importing Sound and Creating Click-Set

1) From the "Sound" menu, select "Manage Click-Set", a dialogue will be appeared.

2) Click "Import Sounds..." button and select (*)sound files that you want to import.

3) Click "Create New Click Set" button, new click set will be added to the list on the left. (Double click the newly created click-set for renaming.)



4) While new click-set selected on the list, choose sounds for each note from popup menu on the right side of the window. (You will find sounds you imported on step 2.)

5) Click "Close" button, newly created click-set will be added to the "Click-Sets" menu.

(*) Only **16bits AIFF** files can be used as a click sound
Use shorter sounds for best result.
