Stickies, Notes, Fire, OmniWeb, ProjectBuilder or TeXShop) and Carbon applications supporting

services.

Installation:

Copy WordService into the directory "Services" (located in the Library folder of your home directory), then log out and log in again. If there's no such folder, just create

one using the Finder.

System requirements:

• Mac OS X 10.1 (or newer)

<u>Usage:</u>

_Select a text and choose the desired menu item in the services menu (or press the appropriate shortcut if available).

Functions & Shortcuts:

The default tabulator width is set to 4. If you want to change this value, modify the file

"org.grunenberg.wordservice.plist" in your preferences-folder using PropertyListEditor,

PrefEdit or a text editor (e.g. TextEdit, ProjectBuilder, BBEdit or Pepper).

Insert:

Inserts files and folders of the selected path (tilde is expanded) and of all its subdirectories (e.g. select the path $'\sim/'$ and this function will insert all contents of your home directory) Cmd-! Date Inserts the current date (no text selection necessary) Date & Time Cmd-% Insert the current date & time (no text selection necessary) Time Insert the current time (no text selection necessary) <u>Speak Text:</u> German Speaks selected text (see above) and tries to convert german into english phonemes. Customization:

If you want to remove unnecessary services or change the menus or shortcuts, you

have to edit the file "info.plist" within the WordService-package (use contextual menus

in the Finder to show the contents).

- Delete elements of the array "NSServices" to remove unnecessary services

- Change the "default"-element of "NSKeyEquivalent"-dictionaries to adapt

shortcuts

- Change the "default"-element of "NSMenultem"-dictionaries to

name or structure of menu-items

Known bugs & limitations:

 Don't use another WordService command while a statistics panel is displayed
Shortcuts are only available after you have at least opened the services-menu once

(seems to be a bug in Mac OS X as this is the case for all services)

• Due to bugs in the service system of Mac OS X up to version 10.2.6, the services

menu might disappear in Carbon applications like the Finder if the number of

service items exceeds a certain number (around 60-70 items usually). Just remove

all unnecessary applications providing services if that's the case.

• In addition some service commands modifying selected text might not work in

Carbon applications like the Finder too (the result just looks like "garbage"). This

is either a bug of those applications or Mac OS X.
