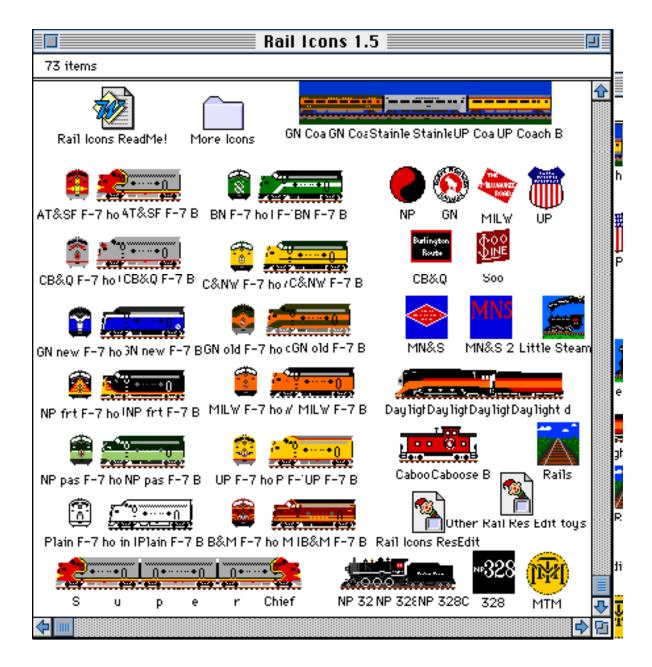

What you should see:

- 6) "Get Info"

- 7) select the icon in the upper left hand corner of the info window
- 8) "Paste" (in the "Edit" menu)
