OS/2 GAINS FINANCIAL PROGRAM

Glendale, California -- The Software Development Group announced the availability of a personal financial software package made specifically for IBM's OS/2 operating system.

MoneyWiz for OS/2 version 1.0, while immediately available, will have its' official introduction at the Computer Expo '95 held at the Los Angeles Convention Center April 22-23 1995.
