PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The imminent release of OS/2 Warp Server at the end of this month has rekindled the interest of the media in this true, 32 bit multithreaded, multitasking operating system. Beta testers report that Warp Server running on the same hardware configuration as Microsoft Windows NT is twice as fast. The single input queue is a thing of the past and security has been added to the package. Add to that the reports that NT security is viable only when in a network situation, and you have another golden opportunity for IBM. The question is -- will IBM be able to take advantage of this one? I think we can all agree that the opportunity IBM had with the l-a-t-e release of Windows 95 was largely wasted.

Well, good news. Reliable rumor has it that IBM is preparing a HUGE marketing blitz coinciding with the release of Warp Server. The end of February (1996) release date seems to be firm. IBM will follow it up with a late June, 1996 release of the new OS/2 Warp (code-named Merlin). Rumor has it that IBM's head honcho said that anyone delaying that release date will find themselves a new place to work. IBM seems serious about providing timely upgrades of our favorite OS.

So, what can we do?

Our job is to spread the word. Let our friends know about the power, flexibility, speed and usability of Warp and the promise of Warp Server. We must bring more members into the TBOUG fold so that they may become educated OS consumers, not brainwashed by Microsoft PR. We know which OS is more stable, is true 32 bit multithreaded, multitasking - and it doesn't come from Bill's house.
