InfoPump - a client/server middleware tool that automates the process of replicating, moving, and integrating data in heterogeneous environments on a scheduled or event-driven basis. InfoPump can replicate or synchro-

nize data from many sources to many targets, including legacy mainframe data, through Platinum's InfoHub or other gateways to RDBMs such as DB2/2 for OS/2, DB2/6000, SYBASE, ORACLE, INFORMIX, and Microsoft SQL Server; to Lotus Notes and to PC data bases via OBDC.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Some exciting things have happened this past month. Our TBOUG meeting featured Joel Krauthem from SPG, Inc. He demonstrated ColorWorks image processing software, a native, 32-bit OS/2 program. I think it was one of the best software demonstrations we've had. The power of the product is incredible and it maximally utilizes OS/2's strong points: multithreading, multitasking and SMP. If you are an Adobe fan, or need to do high-power graphics, this product is highly recommended - and it's only available on OS/2!

As you are all aware, IBM officially announced it's OS/2 Warp Server product on February 26, 1996. It's amazing to note that the product was shipping the next day! Lou Gerstner said he was going to meet announced shipping times, and it seems that IBM is doing just that.

OS/2 Warp Server was reviewed in the March 11, 1996 issue of *InfoWorld* (page 105), and they had some good things to say. *"Enterprises that want to run applications from the server, run Lotus Notes Server on Intel, or ease TCP/IP connectivity should consider implementing OS/2 Warp Server Advanced. This is a no brainer upgrade for OS/2 LAN Server sites."* This is high praise indeed. This is the kind of review OS/2 OS's need -- and deserve.
