PRODUCTION COMMITTEE

John Meroth of Mersoft in Tampa will give a talk on how OS/2 helps him in his daily activities as a Sysop, WebMaster, and Consultant. In particular, he will discuss how he uses OS/2 to manage his web site. John is a software developer specializing in DOS based small business Point of Sale Systems. He has used OS/2 since 2.0 as his primary development platform. He now runs a three workstation network that maintains a BBS, and mail hubbing for Tampa (FIDO) and all of Florida for IBMNet & OS2Net. MAIN MEETING (7:30 - 9:00)

Imaging is the conversion of documents from a physical medium, paper for example, to a digital form where they can be manipulated by computers for easier access and retrieval. Most image management systems include workstations for viewing and manipulating images; storage devices; and servers to manage the image database, run applications software, control peripherals and connect to host devices.

Imaging is a rapidly growing area and as costs have been

lowered for computers and storage, networks have increased in reliability display technology, scanners, and OCR have improved, more and more organizations are implementing the technology.

Our featured speaker for August will be Mr. Steve Pyles, an Imaging Specialist from Xerographics. Xerographics is a leading document imaging vendor located in St. Petersburg, Florida. (Pinellas: 813-570-8868, Tampa: 813-855-6625, Fax: 813-578-0009). Of particular relevance to TBOUG is the fact that Xerographics uses OS/2 Servers for their document management systems. Mr. Pyles will be discussing imaging and document management, addressing the use of OS/2 for their servers and demonstrating the Genesis Information Image Extender which allows extension of imaging to any application.

Document imaging is the future. If you want to learn more about this technology, how it is used, and where it is going, this is the presentation for you.

CONNECT THE WORLD WITH MERLIN

The "Connect the World with Merlin" event scheduled for **Saturday, October 26th** is still snowballing in popularity. We now have volunteers from: Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Hungary, Indonesia, Israel, Italy, Japan, Macao, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Russia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan (ROC), Thailand, the Ukraine, the United Kingdom (locations in Scotland and England), the United States, and Venezuela.

Simply put, the "Connect" promo idea is concerned with helping in the launch of "Merlin" (the next major release of OS/2) by having OS/2 user groups and Team OS/2 members conduct demos of the new product at computer stores throughout the world. Further, the demos would all be connected through the Internet where we would build a map showing where OS/2 is used throughout the world. The demos would also highlight the power of OS/2, including multimedia, multitasking, multithreading, and true 32-bit processing. The benefits of this approach would be considerable:

- It would invigorate computer stores who have historically taken a ho-hum approach to selling OS/2.
- It would dispel the belief that OS/2 isn't widely used.
- It would promote sales by showcasing the features of the product.

- It would galvanize OS/2 customers (e.g., user groups and Team OS/2) through a common promotional program.
- It would be incredibly simple to do.
