Unordered List (Dotted)

```
<UL>  
<LI>First row  
<LI>Second row  
</UL>
```

- This would look like this:
 - First row
 - Second row

Ordered List (Numbered)

```
<OL>  
<LI>First row  
<LI>Second row  
</OL>
```

- This would look like this:
 1. First row
 2. Second row

Preformatted Text - The text here will appear on the web page as it does in the html code.

```
<PRE>  
This    Will  
stay    as  
written exactly  
</PRE>
```

- This will look like this:
