Version 1.1.11 (3Dfx GLide)

In this release the nebula background code as been revised to improve performance on older hardware.

The motion blur option has been re-enabled. However, due to the 16 bit color limitation of current 3Dfx hardware, when motion blur is chosen, only the backdrop stars are displayed.

Fixed a problem with CD audio that would not play tracks in random order. Also fixed a bug that allowed exiting the screen saver with Control-Alt-Delete, even when password protected.

Automatic "un-installation" was also added in this version.

Voodoo Lights and Cosmos-1 are meant to be used in Voodoo I and Voodoo II cards. Banshee support is not guaranteed.

Voodoo Rush is not supported.

Performance Notes.

To achieve the best results, **Voodoo Lights and Cosmos**¹ both require a good CPU. A Voodoo II card is ideal and will produce the best results. Performance on Voodoo I cards should be adequate with a good CPU. On lower end machines the background nebula will probably have to be disabled.

Testing.

This version has been tested on Voodoo I and II cards.

Banshee remains untested and probably unsupported. Donation of one of these cards would be most welcome. (Any generous card maker out there?)
