There really isn't much to using Wallpick. It is a simple utility that allows you to quickly try out any number of different bitmap files for your Windows wallpaper. Wallpick uses its own variation of the file-opening common dialog box for simplicity. Thus, for any control not listed below, you must consult your Windows User's Manual for help.

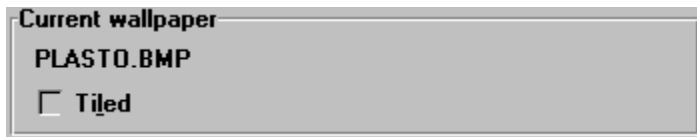

## Preview Button

The preview button is the default button for Wallpick (i.e. it gets activated when the Enter key is pressed). It uses the currently selected file as the Windows wallpaper.

## Restore Button

The restore button will restore the original wallpaper settings that were in effect when the Wallpick application was invoked.

## **Current Wallpaper Display**

This region of the screen displays the filename and tiling status of the wallpaper currently being displayed.

## Tiled Checkbox

This checkbox indicates whether or not wallpaper tiling is in effect. If checked, wallpaper tiling is enabled; otherwise, it is disabled.
