- These images are a sample of the color mosaics which will be published in the near future as a CD-ROM available through the Planetary Data System and the National Space Science Data Center;
- The creation of these special color mosaics was done by the United States Geological Survey (USGS), Branch of Astrogeology, Flagstaff, Arizona by careful rectification of the original imagery from the Viking Orbiter spacecraft;
- The colors do not represent a true rendition of the colors of Mars; they are enhanced to improve the visibility of subtle details on the surface;
- These samples are only preliminary and anyone wishing to use such images in either paper or digital publications should wait for the availability of the final versions with the release of the CD-ROM. The images on the CD-ROM, once it is released, will be in the public domain.
