

WINMOD - Change Directory

I have used .MOD file using TrakBlasterPro that I got from the VGA-Spectrum Compact Disk. There are a lot of .MOD files on that disk that I would like to access using the WINMOD Player in June's issue of Nautilus. When I open the WINMOD program and try to access the .MOD file, I can only browse the C:\ directory. My question is... Is there any way that I can change the directory path from within the WINMOD Player? The only directories that seem to be available are the subdirectories on my C drive. I would like to be able to change the Path to G:\, which is my CD ROM drive. Otherwise I have to use the File Manager and launch the file to the minimized icon or the file icon. Please let me know.

Unfortunately, WINMOD only allows you to browse the current directory. Should you wish to play the .MOD files on Nautilus or from another CD, you can do so by one of the following ways. 1. Copy the .MOD files to your hard drive, launch WINMOD, and then open the files. 2. Launch the files from File Manager. Of course you will need to do a File Association. Sorry for the inconvenience. Hope you are enjoying the .MOD files; you'll find more this issue in the Games & Diversions section.
