DoubleSpace crashes Dan E. Hedgpeth, Blythe, CA, USA

I'd like to pass on a small 'bug' to everyone. When I upgraded to MS-DOS 6 and activated DoubleSpace, I was unable to run .AVI and .MID files, and could not read .WRI files. Reason? The files were compressed, but MS-DOS 6 would not uncompress them for Nautilus. In fact, it wouldn't uncompress them for stand-alone programs either. I have a 486/25 clone with 8 MB RAM, 211 MB HD, SVGA with Farenheit 1280 card, Future Domain SCSI card and a Mitsumi CD ROM drive, tied into an SBPro 2.0 sound card. I have all the latest drivers for all this equipment (except the F1280.) I was finally forced to dump everything and re-install, without DoubleSpace. I do have Stacker 3.0 in the new setup, everything works fine, I think.
